

Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army raided many Palestinian houses in 'Azzun village east of Qaliliya city and arrested Naji Radwan(18 years old) and Al'a Mansur(16 years old).
- The Israeli Occupation Army raided Al 'Arrub refugee camp and arrested Fadi Mohamd Abu Zidan(21 years old) and took him to unknown destination. Also the IOA, raided Idhna town and searched the house of Imad Abdalla Al Batran and messed with its contents.
- The Israeli Troops raided Sa'ir town north east of Hebron and several of neighborhoods in the city, erected military checkpoints and searched

Palestinian cars and checked in their ID cards causing obstruction in their movements.

• The Israeli Occupation Army stormed Sayda town north of Tulkarim city. The IOA, erected flying checkpoints east and north of the city and started checking the ID cards of the citizens.

Israeli Military orders

 The Israeli Occupation Army handed 3 Palestinian residents from Nahalin village west of Bethlehem city demolition orders under the pretext of lacking building license. The threatened houses owned by; Hassam Kamal Hassan Shakarna, Ahmad Yusuf Abd Al Hamid, Hassan Nimer Mahmud Othman.
