## Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

20 February 2012

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

## Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested 'Adi Fahim Hassan Al-'Alami (25 year sold) from Beit Ummar town in Hebron city, after storming his house.
- The Israeli Occupation Army raided and searched a number of Palestinian houses in Nablus city and arrested Majdi Hamd Allah Hassan Fatayer (35 years old) from Rafidyia area.

- Israeli soldiers chased a number of Palestinian workers on the road of 'Arad south of Hebron city, detained number of them and destroyed their cars. In addition to that, clashes broke between the Amy and citizens in Halhul town north of the city, the Army fired tear gas and sound bombs causing injuries to residents. The IOA also raided a number of Palestinian houses.
- Israeli Occupation Army abducted a Palestinian from the Palestinian Red Crescent Society (PRCS) headquarters in Ramallah. Omar Abu Rowis, from Al Amari refugee camp who works as a security guard at PRCS, was abducted in broad daylight.

## Israeli Settlers Violence

• Israeli settlers wrote racist slogans against Christians and Christianity and price tag on the walls of a Baptist church in Hegdam Street in Jerusalem city. In addition to that, settlers punctured tires for 3 cars parked in the church compound.
