Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

 Israeli occupation Army arrested Salem Abu Al-Reesh from Surif after storming his house, messed with its contents; The IOA also conducted tight search at different neighborhoods and areas in Hebron, erected flying checkpoints at the crossroads, the entrances of towns and villages of Hebron city, detained Palestinian citizens in Jabal Al Rahma area, and started checking their ID's.

Others

• The destruction of the Givat Assaf illegal outpost will be postponed by half a year. The High Court of Justice has been dealing with the case of Givat Assaf since 2007. In February 2011, the Israeli government decided to change direction and legalize all outposts built on state owned land and dismantle those built on private Palestinian –owned land by the end of 2011.
