



Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

12 November 2011

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army raided Yatta, Beit Ummar, Wadi Abu Kteleh, Adh Dhahiriya neighborhood, As Salam Street, Aien Sara and Nimra area in Hebron Governorate.
- The Israeli army stationed at the military towers in Khuza'a town and Al Farahin area east of Khan Yunis town in Gaza strip opened fire at Palestinian houses and farmers
- Israeli Occupation Army arrested Salam Afana and Sa'ed Afana from Salfit; while they were harvesting olive trees.

- Israeli Occupation Army arrested Tha'er Ahmad Khalil Abu Hisham(24 years old) from Beit Ummar town north of Hebron city.

Erection of the Israeli Checkpoints

- Israeli Occupation Army set up a number of military checkpoints at the entrance of Sa'ir, Beit Ummar and Idhna towns in Hebron Governorate; stopped Palestinian cars and started checking the ID' cards.
