

### Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

23, 24 October 2011

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

The daily report does not necessarily reflect ARIJ's opinion.

## Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli occupation Army with 4 military vehicles raided Tulkarm city northwest of the West Bank and roamed its streets and neighborhoods in the eastern area, stationed on Nablus Street in front of Tulkarem refugee camp. No injuries were reported. Furthermore, Israeli Army closed Enav military checkpoint for maintenance to the east of the city, which caused obstructed the vehicular movements.
- Israeli occupation Army raided Beit Iksa village northwest of Jerusalem city in search for a Palestinian youth who allegedly stabbed Israeli man in Ramot neighborhood in east Jerusalem. The IOF closed the entrances

to the village and hindered Palestinians from leaving or entering it also searched houses and arrested 2 Palestinians.

- The Israeli occupation Army arrested Farouq 'Ashour (37 years old),
  Hassan Badawi Abu Snineh(21 years old),lead them to unkown
  destination. Furthermore, the Israeli troops raided the entrance of
  Halhoul and Al Fawar refugee camp stopped the citizen's cars and
  checked the ID cards.
- The Israeli occupation forces arrested Nihad Abed Al Halim Taqtqa (23 years old) and Ridad Ibrahim Taqatqa (23 years old) after storming their houses in Beit Fajar town south of Bethlehem city.
- The Israeli occupation Army raided the house of Na'im Mohammad Abed Al Mohtaseb and arrested his brother Amer Abed Al Mohtaseb (42 years old) and took him to an unknown destination from Hebron Governorate. The IOF stopped and searched in citizen's cars, checked their ID cards.
- The Israeli occupation soldiers stationed at the checkpoint near Al Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron Governorate arrested Tariq Ershed (16 years old) and took him to an unknown destination.

#### Home Demolition and Demolition Threats

Resident Ahmad Abed Al Rahim Al Bilisy was forced to demolish his
house by himself in Yaqout Al Hamawi Street in Wadi Al Joz in
Jerusalem city before the hearing session of the Municipal court is held
on the 25th of October 2011 and to avoid paying a fine of 50 thousand
NIS (USD 14000). Al Bilisy indicated that the officers of Jerusalem
Municipality came and ordered him to halt the construction at his
house and asked him to get permits for it.

### **Erections of Israeli Checkpoint**

 Israeli occupation Army set up military checkpoint at the entrance of Turmus'ayya village in Ramallah Governorate, and arrested Handala Yousef Rashid (18 years old), Majd Walled Mohammad Abu Al Njoum (18 years old) and Ramzi Hisham Al Natour.Morover, the IOF arrested Applied Research Institute - Jerusalem (ARIJ)
