Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 13 April 2012

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Four Palestinians people were injured and many others suffered Gas Inhalation during the weekly peaceful demonstration that took place in Kafr Qaddum village east of Qalqilyah city demanding the opening of the main road of the village that has been closed for years by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA). The IOA also sprayed Palestinian houses with contaminated chemical water. Wafa (April 13, 2012).
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) attacked Palestinian citizens, volunteers and staff working in a field hospital that was set up in Tel

Rumeida neighborhood in Hebron, in the olive groves, near the Al Arba'een Mosque, which was closed by the IOA some years ago. The IOA surrounded the field hospital, detained a number of Palestinian citizens and staff working in it, and conducted inspections to them after detaining them for long hours. Wafa (April 13, 2012).

- Two Palestinians (an elderly and a young boy) suffered gas Inhalation as the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) fired Gas Bombs at them in Wadi Al Jooz area in Bani Na'im village in Hebron Governorate. Wafa (April 13, 2012).
- Tens of Palestinians and International activists were hit and suffered Gas Inhalation in An Nabi Saleh village north of Ramallah as the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed the village and suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration that took place in solidarity with the Palestinian prisoners. A young Palestinian (Osama Bilal Al Tamimi, 15 years) was hit in the eye with a live bullet and two other international activists were also injured. The house of Kamel Ayyoub Al Tamimi was set on fire as the IOA fired gas bombs towards the house. Wafa (April 13, 2012).
- Nine Palestinians and International activists were injured and suffered Gas Inhalation as the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration held in Bil'in village west of Ramallah city. Among injurers, the following were known: Jamal Huweil, 'Atta Abu Rmeila, 'Asem Yaseen, Rasheed Al Khateeb, Ahmad Isma'il, Khaled Al Khateeb, Muhammad Fatayer, Ahmad Amr and Nadeem Al Sharabati. Wafa (April 13, 2012).

Israeli Arrests

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested resident Mahmoud Nazzal (24 years) from Qabatyia village east of Jenin city after detaining him for many hours at 'Atara checkpoint near Ramallah. Pal Press (April 13, 2012).
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested resident Tha'er Ghannam (16 years) after raiding his house in the old city of Hebron and took him to unknown destination. Pal Press (April 13, 2012).
- The Israeli Occupation army (IOA) arrested five Palestinian farmers from Aqraba village in Nablus Governorate while on their way back to their village along with their agricultural tractors. The farmers clashed with Israeli settlers of Itamar settlement who shot live bullets and hurled stones at them. Al Quds (April 13, 2012).

Israeli settlers' Violence

- Israeli settlers of Kiryat Arba' settlement established on lands of Hebron city attacked citizen Shaker Al Tamimi (63 years) and his son Muhannad (19 years) while they were working in their land in Jabal Jales (Jales Mountain) near the settlement. The settlers also uprooted tens of Olive trees and destroyed field crops planted in Al Tamimi's land and other neighboring Palestinian lands. Wafa (April 13, 2012).
- Israeli settlers of Avigal outpost uprooted and destroyed 24 Olive trees in Al Kharouba area east of Yatta town south of Hebron city. The trees belong to Jibril Musa Khalil Rubi'. Israeli settlers also chased Palestinian Sheperds and International activists who were documenting the incident and hurled stones at Palestinian houses. Wafa (April 13, 2012).
