Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 21 April 2012

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

 The Israeli Occupation bulldozers razed and uprooted 500 Olive trees in Athaher area north of Salfit City owned by Ahmad Theib 'Alqam and Sameer Al Masri. The IOA also destroyed supporting Stone Wall and metal corners in the site. Wafa (April 21, 2012)

Israeli Arrests

- The Israeli Occupation Authorities renewed for the second time on row the administrative detention of Muhammad Karam Fayez Nassra (43 years), a member of Jenin Municipality. Mr. Nassar was arrested on the 22nd of November 2011. Safa (April 21, 2012).
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested five Palestinians in a weekly peaceful demonstration that was held in Yatta town south of Hebron city. The IOA hindered Palestinian farmers and Peace Activists from reaching Al Kharrouba area in Masafer yatta to demonstrate against hindering Palestinian farmers from reaching their lands in the area and grazing their sheep. The arrestees are: Fadel Hamamda (45 years), Hussein Mahmoud Hamamda (18 Years), Mahmoud Hussein Hamamda (45 years), Na'em Salem Al 'Adra (44 years) and Mu'ath Hamamda (20 years). Israeli Settlers' Violence

• Israeli settlers attacked local and international law professors participating in a conference regarding Palestine's membership at the United Nations, organized by the Hebron University, in Hebron city, in the southern part of the West Bank. The professors were touring in Ash-Shallalah Street, next to the illegal settlement outpost of Beit Hadassah. IMEMC (April 21, 2012).

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

• The Israeli Occupation Army forced owners of billboard set up at Jericho's southern entrance to demolish it under the pretext of being set up in an area classified as "C" area. Al Quds (April 21, 2012).
