



Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

1 December 2011

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

The daily report does not necessarily reflect ARIJ's opinion.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army raided the house of Mohammad Ali Al Hremi, searched it and messed with its contents, before arresting his son Zaid Al Hremi (17 years old) in Al Saff street in Bethlehem city.
- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested Mohamad Atef Abu 'Aker (15 years old), after raiding his house and messing with its properties.
- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested Ashraf Mohi Al Deen Hamama (35 years old) from Tubas after storming and messing with house contents.

- Israeli Occupation Army raided Jenin city and arrested a number of Palestinian citizens: Nasir Abd Al Afo Abu 'Aziz(55 years old), Adalla 'Afif Zakarna(44 years old), Salah (50 years old), Samah Abdala Zughbi (45 years old) Zaher Nafez Abu Sakha (48 years old), Zohair Zughbi (61 years old), Fad'a Ra'ouf Zughbi (48 years old) Alam Sami Musad (44 years old), Mohamad Abu Sharar Abu Al Haija (36 years old) after raiding their houses and messing with their properties.
- Israeli Occupation Army raided Beit Furik town east of Nablus city, raided a number of Palestinian houses and arrested Sajed Abd Al Latif Mlitat (40 years old), Ayman 'Aref Hajaj Mohammad (44 years old) and Yousef Mohamad Yousef Abu Ghalmi (38 years old).
- The Israeli Occupation Army stormed Dura town southwest of Hebron Governorate and arrested Monther Mohamad Abu Attwan, after storming his house and messing with its contents. Meanwhile, the IOA set up military checkpoints in Hebron city, at the entrances of Halhul and Edhna towns.
- The Israeli occupation soldiers arrested Ahmad Khamis 'Akila (25 years old) while trying to access Beit Hanoun crossing, on his way to Saint John Hospital in Jerusalem to receive treatment for one of his eyes.
- **The-Islamic-Christian-Commission-in-Support-of-Jerusalem** and Holy –Sites warns of an Israeli plan to expand the place of prayers of Jewish women in the wailing wall area through the construction of an underground floor and surrounding it by walls on all sides.
- The Israeli Occupation Army razed 6 permanent structures in the outpost of Givat Ariyeh located near Itamar settlement in Nablus city.

Home Demolition and Demolition Threats

- Israeli Occupation Army accompanied by the Israeli Occupation bulldozers raided the western area of Husan village nearby the settlement of Betar Illit, demolished a retaining wall belonging to Hassan Mohamd Hamamra, as well as a plant nursery owned by Mohamad Bajis Shusha. In addition, the IO bulldozers demolished a

car spare parts shop owned by Hasan Mohamad Odeh Hamamra and confiscated the equipments inside the shop; and demolished a car wash shop owned by Firas Sabri Shusha. The process wasn't only limited to the demolition of properties, but the IOA also stole around 6 tons of construction iron owned by Fuad Hussan Shusha. Further more, the Israeli troops arrested the 3 Shawasheh brothers; Abdul Hay, Ibrahim , and Mahmud.

- The Israeli Occupation Army handed residents of As Samu' town and Khallet Al Karsanna (Al Karsana Hamlet) and Khallet Al Mafateeh notifications to halt the construction at their houses. The orders were handed to Mohamad Na'im Abu Al Kabash, Nabil Yousef Hamad Al Mhareq, Nada Hamad Abdl Minem Al Mahareq, Hamad Mahmud Hamad Al Mahareq, Nawaf Hamad Abdl Minem Al Mahareq.
