



Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

7 December 2011

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested 12 Palestinian citizen from Nablus governorate, they are: Mohammad Ghazal, Wad Yousef Abdal Haq (a professor at An Najah University), Samih 'Aliwi in Ras Al 'Ein, Aseed Hasiba (17 years old), Mo'ayad Hasiba (20 years old), Samir Al Asata and Bah'a Ya'esh (53 years old).
- A Palestinian citizen was killed and 5 others were injured by Israeli air strike east of Ash Shuja'ieh neighborhood in Gaza city.

- The Israeli Occupation Army raided Al 'Arrub refugee camp in Hebron city and carried out military operations in the camp, during which the IOA stormed the house of Mahmud Zidan (22 years old), head of the student union of Bethlehem University. The IOA, also arrested Ismail Mohammad Al Zeer (35 years old) and Maher Mohamd Abu Sarhan after storming their houses in Tequ' and Al ' Ubadiya villages east of Bethlehem city.
- The Israeli Occupation Army raided a number of Palestinian neighborhoods in Hebron city and arrested Mo'taz Salim Al Herbawi, Abdulla Zghair, Mohammad Ibrahim Tawaiha (21 years old) and Firas Abdal Hadi Al Sa'di (24 years old) from Halhul town, and took them to unknown destination.
- The Israeli Occupation Army summoned the released prisoner Rima Daraghma to interview the Israeli Intelligence at Salem military camp north of Jenin city.

Israeli Settlers Violence

- Israeli settlers set fire into the mosque of Bruqin village in Salfit governorate and burned all its contents and a number of Palestinians cars.

Israeli Military Orders

- The Israeli Occupation Army handed a number of Palestinian families in Khirbet Susiya southeast of Hebron city military orders to halt the construction of 8 residential structures and 5 water wells. The military orders were issued under the pretext of building without proper licensing. The threatened structure are owned by; Jamal Hakam Abu Malash, Mohammad Khalil Al Nawaja'a, Mohamad Hamdan Mdalal, Jebiril Khalil Al Nwaja'a, Khalil Mohamad Muslim Al Nawaja'a and Ehssan Mohammad Al Smiran.
