



Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

10 December 2011

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli warplanes shelled at an empty land west of Rafah city south of Gaza city, no injuries were reported.
- Nabil Mustafa Tamimi (27 years old), a Palestinian protester who was seriously injured after being hit by a gas bomb during the Friday's weekly protest in An Nabi Salih village in Ramallah Governorate, died suffering of his wounds at Rabin Medical Center in Petah Tikva.
- The Israeli Occupation Army attacked and beat Haytham Ibrahim Yousef Qebha (35 years old) from Barta'a ash Sharqiya village west of Jenin city.

- The Israeli Occupation Army raided Kafr Qaddum village east of Qalqilyah city and set up a military checkpoint at the western entrance of the village. The IOF stopped Palestinian cars and checked residents' ID cards, causing obstruction to the vehicular and pedestrian movements.
