## Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

16 February 2012

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

## Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

• Six Palestinian civilians have been wounded in two Israeli air strikes targeted a residential structure in at-Tuffah neighborhood in east of Gaza city and another structure in the Nusseirat area in the central Gaza Strip causing damage to properties but no injuries were reported.

- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested Hamud 'Ala Samara (16 years old), Samih Jadalla Khatib (16 years old) and Bassil Raed Khatib (17 years old) from Bil'in village west of Ramallah city.
- Israeli Occupation Army invaded the offices and homes of three Palestinian Parliament members and confiscated their computers and cell phones in Jenin city. Israeli occupation troops broke into the house and office of Ibrahim Dahbour, Khaled Suleian and Khaled and were interrogated by an Israeli intelligence officer. The invading troops took the cell phones, computers and some private documents form their homes without showing any search warrant.

## Israeli Settlers Violence.

- Israeli settlers set fire into a Palestinian car owned by Mohamd Habun, while its was parked outside his house in An Nabi Elyas town east of Qalqilyah city. As well, they wrote racist slogans against Arabs and Muslims on the wall of the house.
- More than 500 Israeli settlers operating under the protection of Israeli Occupation Army stormed Jospeh tomb east of Nablus city and practiced religious rituals.
