Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 3 February 2012

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army stationed at one flying military checkpoints and arrested Fida Abd Al-Latiff Sharfa (32 years old), working at the Palestinian Police and Hamed Sadeq Shtawi; a student at Al Najah University from Kaffr Qadum town east of Qalqilyah.
- A number of Palestinian citizens were injured in the peaceful demonstration that took place in Bil'in village west of Ramallah. The

IOA used tear gas bombs and rubber bullets and sprayed dozens of activists by waste water mixed with chemicals.

- The Israeli Occupation Army suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration against the wall and settlements that took place in Kafr Qaddum village in Qalqilyah Governorate. The IOA used tear gas bombs and rubber bullets.
- Clashes broke between Israeli Occupation Army and Palestinian citizens after the IOA raided Palestinian houses in 'Asyida area in Beit Ummar town north of Hebron city, where the IOA fired bullets and bombs sounds to disperse the citizens who threw stones at the Israeli soldiers, no injuries and arrests were reported.
- A number of Palestinians along with International activists marched in the demonstration that took place in Nil'in village northwest of Ramallah city. The Israeli Occupation Army used tear gas bombs and rubber bullets.
- The Israeli Occupation Army suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration against the wall and settlements that took place in An Nabi Saleh village northwest of Ramallah city. The IOA used tear gas bombs and rubber bullets and sprayed dozens of activists by waste water mixed with chemicals causing injuries to number of activists and detained journalist Ali Dar Ali and Photographer Najeb Shawarna for a couple of hours, the IOA tried to prevent the journalist from covering the events.
- Israeli Occupation Army suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration against the wall and settlements that took place in Al Mas'ra village in Bethlehem city.
- Israeli warplanes fired on sites across the Gaza Strip injuring a young man from Salman family and a child; Haiya Taha (4 years old) and caused damages to a number of Palestinian houses in Beit Lahiya city. Also in the southern Gaza strip, Israeli Army fired on a house east of Rafah and open lands near Bani Suheila east of Khan Younis. At least one of the airstrikes targeted a tunnel in Rafah.

Israeli Settlers Violence

- A number of Israeli settlers of Masskiyot settlement attacked and beat Mahdi Ali Daraghma (24 years old) from 'Ein Al Maleh area in Tubas Governorate while he was grazing his sheep.
- Approximately 250 Israeli settlers accompanied by Israeli Border Police officers, invaded Al-Carmel village, and installed six new caravans in Um Ash-Shuqhan area, near the Ma'on illegal outpost that was established on privately owned Palestinian lands. In addition to that, about 150 settlers attacked Palestinian farmlands in Za'ta area, east of Beit Ummar, and blocked the Jerusalem-Hebron road in front of Palestinian traffic.

Confiscation & Razing of Lands

- The Israeli Municipality of Jerusalem decided to take over parking a lot for cars in the Armenian Quarter in the old city of Jerusalem to establish a settlement building.
