Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

4 February 2012

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army detained three Palestinian citizens from Qebha family from Tura village near Ya'bad town south of Jenin city, and raided 'araba, Siris, Mitholin and Az Zababda.
- The Israeli Occupation Army stationed at a sudden military checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum village and arrested Mahmud Abd Al Qader Abd Allah (22 years old) while on his way back to the village.

Also, the IOA stopped the Palestinian cars and checked in their ID cards.

• The Israeli Occupation Army arrested Palestinian citizens and international activists after attacking the demonstration that took place in Beit Ummar town. The IOA used tear gas and rubber bullets causing injuries to number of activists in the demonstration, of them; Sadeq Abu Maria (40 years old) was known. The demonstration was held in attempt to plant olive trees in Kallet al Kutla area near Karmi Tzur settlement.

Erection of Israeli checkpoints

 The Israeli Occupation Army set a up military checkpoint at the entrance of Zabuba village west of Jenin and announce it a closed military area and prevented citizens from going in and out of the village.
