Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

6 January 2012

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

 The Israeli Occupation Army closed the Iron Gat southwest of Ya'bad town which links several communities in Yab'ad area and Baqa Ash-Sharqia village with Jenin city. The closure of the gate forbid thousands of Palestinian citizens and farmers from moving.

- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested Ali Abdala Abu Al-Rab (52 years old) and his son; Dajana (20 years old) while crossing Za'tara military checkpoint south of Nablus city.
- The Israeli Occupation Army prevented residents of Tura Al-Gharbiya village southwest of Jenin city from installing a water network in the village and detained head of the village council; Mahmud Jamal Zaid for more than two hours and prevented him from repairing the water network.
- Israeli Occupation Army suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration against the wall and settlements that took place in Al Mas'ra village in Bethlehem city injuring Mahmud Sliman (40 years old).
- A number of Palestinian citizens along with International activists
 were injured as the Israeli Occupation Army suppressed the peaceful
 demonstration that took place in in Kafr Qaddum village in Qalqilyah
 Governorate. The IOA used tear gas bombs and rubber bullets and
 sprayed dozens of activists by waste water mixed with chemicals.
- The Israeli Occupation Army suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration against the wall and settlements that took place in An Nabi Saleh village northwest of Ramallah city. The IOA raided the village targeting Palestinian houses, and closed the roads.
- A number of Palestinian citizens were injured in the peaceful demonstration that took place in Bil'in village west of Ramallah, which marked the first anniversary of the death of Jawaher Abu Rahma. The IOA used tear gas and rubber bullets.
- A number of Palestinians along with International activists were injured as the Israeli Occupation Army suppressed the peaceful demonstration that took place in Kafr Ad-Dik village west of Salfit city. The IOA used tear gas bombs and rubber bullets.
- The Israeli Occupation tanks stationed at the eastern borders of Gaza city and shelled at open areas east of Jabalya refugee camp, no injuries were reported.
