Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

2 March 2012

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration against the wall and settlements that took place in Kafer Qaddum in Qalqilyah Governorate, demanding to open the village's street. The IOA used tear gas bombs and rubber bullets. As a result, dozens of citizens among international activists were wounded as the Army hindered dozens of protesters from reaching the gate which closes the street and sprayed dozens of activists with waste water.

- A number of Palestinian citizens among International activists were injured and suffered from tear gas inhalation in the peaceful demonstration that took place in Bil'in village. The IOA used tear gas bombs and rubber bullets.
- The Israeli Occupation Army suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration against the wall and settlements that took place in An Nabi Salih village in Ramallah Governorate. The IOA used tear gas bombs and rubber bullets. As a result, dozens of citizens among international activists were wounded as the army hindered dozens of protesters from reaching the segregation wall area.
