## Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

7 March 2012

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

### Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army raided the houses of released prisoners; Ahmad Walid Abu Srur (23 years old) and Mohammad Fayez Nimer Shni'at (24 years old) in Sibat neighborhood in Jenin city, questioned them for hours and threatened to re-arrest them in case they practice any political activity.
- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested 12 Palestinian citizens after raiding several areas in the West Bank.

- Israeli settlers raided a spring water in Qarawet Bani Zeid north of Ramallah city, attacked Palestinian citizens near the spring water, and fired live bullets in the air before withdrawing from the village.
- The Israeli Occupation Army detained dozens of Palestinian cars and checked citizens' ID cards at Atara checkpoint north of Ramallah city.
- The Israeli Occupation Army confiscated 15 Palestinian vehicles in Barta'a ash Sharqiya village south of Jenin city; the IOA also raided the commercial market and the industrial area.
- 2 Israeli bulldozers and 3 tanks moved tens of kilometers into Beit Hanun city north of Gaza city, leveled areas of Palestinian lands and closed Beit Hanun crossroad.
- The Israeli Occupation Army raided Beit Ummar town north of Hebron city and arrested Zain Hisham Khalil Abu Hisham (15 years old), Sami 'Amer Ahmad Abu Juda (15 years old) and Sa'ed Imad Mohamad Slebi (16 years old) after raiding their houses. In addition to that, the Army raided Yatta town and arrested Fadi Samir Abu Hamid (17 years old), Mohamd Al-Dameri (20 years old) and Hani Ayed Sha'bin.
- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested Hassan Al Qawasmi (30 years old), Khamis Salah Al-Natsha (22 years old) from Hebron city.
- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested Mohamad Ali Abd Al-Rahman Bidwan (17 years old) from Azzun town east of Qalqilyah, after storming his house and messing with its contents. It is worth mentioning that a number of Army vehicles raided the town with intensive of shooting.
- The Israeli Occupation Army raided two houses of released prisoners; Ahmad Walid Abu Srur and Mohamad Fayez Shni'at in Jenin city, questioned them for hours and threatened to re-arrest them if they practice any political activity.
- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested a Palestinian citizen and detained his family in Al Khadr village south of Bethlehem city while they were cultivating their lands near Eli'zer settlement established on the lands of village. The IOA ordered the family to stop working in the lands under the pretext that all in the lands and confiscated

agricultural equipments and 100 olive trees awaiting cultivation. Furthermore, the Army arrested Sajed (22 years old) and took him to Etzion settlement bloc south of Bethlehem city. As well, the Israeli Army prevented farmers from entering the lands another time or they will be arrest.
