Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

11 May 2012

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Warships opened its fires at Palestinian fishing boats in Gaza Sea. No injures were reported. Wafa (May 11, 2012).
- A Palestinian citizen (Majed Salah Al Barghouthi, 18 years) was seriously injured in his eye in 'Abud Village northwest of Ramallah city as the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) suppressed a peaceful demonstration held in the village in Solidarity with Palestinian prisoners who are on Hunger strike. Wafa (May 11, 2012).

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) broke the glass of a digger owned by Imad Hamdi Abu Maria who was working in reclaiming the land of Waleed Sabarneh. Wafa (May 11, 2012).
- Tens of Palestinians and international activists suffered Gas Inhalation as the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration held in Al Ma'sara village south of Bethlehem city in solidarity with Palestinian prisoners who are on hunger strike. Wafa (May 11, 2012).
- The Israeli Occupation Army raided Kafr Qaddum village east of Qalqilyah city, set up a military checkpoint at its entrance and declared it a closed zone. Wafa (May 11, 2012).
- Three Journalists were injured and Tens of Palestinians suffered Gas Inhalation as the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration held in Kafr Qaddum village east of Qalqilyah city. The injured Journalists are: Ajwad Jaradat from Palestine satellite channel, 'Ala Badarneh and Ja'far Ishtayeh. Wafa (May 11, 2012).
- Tens of Palestinians suffered Gas Inhalation as the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration held in An Nabi Saleh village in Ramallah Governorate in solidarity with the Palestinian prisoners who are on hunger strike. Wafa (May 11, 2012).
- Tens of Palestinians and international activists suffered Gas Inhalation and tens of Olive trees were set to fire as the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration held in Bil'in village in solidarity with the Palestinian prisoners who are on hunger strike. Wafa (May 11, 2012).
- Two Palestinians (Khaldoun Jameel Masharqa and Hammad Ahmad Abu Maria) were injured in Beit Ummer town north of Hebron city as clashes erupted between the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) and Palestinian citizens at the town's entrance. The IOA occupied the roof tops of a number of houses in the town, of which the following were known: The house of Jamal Khalil Al 'Alami, Abdel Aziz Abu Ayyas, Mahmoud Saleh Ayyash and 'Ayed 'Alqam.

Israeli Arrests

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians from the Old city of Jerusalem, Muhammad Ash Shaweesh and Adnan Al Rajabai under the pretext of assaulting a settler in the city. Wafa (May 11, 2012).
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested a Palestinian Shepherd, Najeeb Muhammad Ahmad Mershed (19 YEARS), from Kafr Ra'I

village south of Jenin city after raiding his family house and searching it. Wafa (May 11, 2012).

- Israeli Occupation authorities renewed for three months the administrative detention of Khaled Tafesh, a member of the Palestinian Legislative Council. The decision means that Tafesh will serve another three months in detention without charge after his original six-month term ends in late July. Maannews (May 11, 2012).

Israeli Settlers' Violence

- A group of Israeli Settlers from Eli'zaer settlement destroyed 150 Olive saplings planted in Al 'Absiya area in Al Khader village west of Bethlehem city and are owned by citizen Ali Ahmad Hamad Salah. Wafa (May 11, 2012).
- Israeli settlers of Karmeit Zur settlement attacked and beat a Waleed Muhammad Suleiman Sabarneh (30 years) while working in his land which lies close to the aforementioned settlement. Mr. Sabarneh suffered bruises in all his body parts. Wafa (May 11, 2012).
