Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 2 January 2012

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

The daily report does not necessarily reflect ARIJ's opinion.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested teacher Foad Mahmud Ahmad Mahamid (26 years old) and Adham Tawfiq Abu Murad (25 years old) after storming their houses and messing with their contents in At Tyba village.

- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested Sa'ed and Abd Al Hamid Eshtaiya from Salim village in Nablus Governorate.
- The Israeli Occupation Army raided Hebron city and arrested Amran 'Azam Bader (21 years old), Yousef Daoud Saleh Al Zgahir (22 years old) and Mahmud Ahmad Yousef Abu Snieneh (55 years old) and took them to an unknown destination. Also, the IOA raided Al 'Arrub refugee camp and arrested 3 Palestinian citizens and stormed Yatta, Idhna, Ash Shiokh and Sa'ir towns where they stopped Palestinian cars and checked their ID cards.
- Israeli gunboats shelled at Palestinian fishing boats in Al Waha area northwest of Gaza city, no injuries were reported.
- The Israeli Occupation soldiers handed a number of Palestinians in Ras Al-Amud neighborhood in Silwan town notifications to interview the Israeli Intelligence at Al Maskobiyeh detention center west of Jerusalem. Notifications were handed to Raja'I Al Abasi (24 years old), Mohammad Al Abasi (19 years old) and Mohammad Mahmud Al Abasi (17 yaesr old). The IOA also stormed several Palestinian houses, conducted thorough search campaigns and military operations. The Israeli soldiers questioned Muslim Odeh (11 years old), Mohammad Odeh (13 years old) and Ahmad Al Rajbi (13 years old).

Home Demolition and Demolition Threats

- The Israeli Occupation Army handed out a number of Palestinian citizens and farmers orders to demolish barracks and rooms in Deir Hejla and Al Zur lands southeast Jericho city.

Israeli Military Orders

- The Israeli Municipality of Jerusalem issued an order to confiscate 13 dunums of lands in an industrial area in Wadi Al Joz. The targeted land is located at the crossroad of Hebrew University, near the "Rokfeler Museum". The Israeli military order gave citizens 60 days time to file objections against the military order. It is worth pointing out that the Israeli military order was issued on September 20, 2011 but was only served to citizens on the 2 of January 2011.

Others

- The Israeli occupation authorities decided to demolish Karni (al-Muntar) commercial crossing and move all commercial traffic to Kerem Shalom between Israel and Egypt. The crossing has been closed for about a year by the Israeli army.
