



Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

18 November 2011

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstration organized by the local Popular Committees against the wall and settlements in the 23 anniversary of the Declaration of Independence Day that took place in Bil'in village in Ramallah governorate. The IO troops used tear gas bombs, rubber bullets and bomb sounds where dozens of Palestinian residents along with International activists were injured.
- The Israeli Occupation soldiers attacked the funeral of Sa'ed Shahda Addi (78 years old) and Mahmud Mussa Al Slabi (75 years old) in Beit

Ummar town in Hebron city. The IO threw tear gas bombs at citizens during the funeral and at the Palestinian houses.

- Number of Palestinian citizens were injured as the Israeli Occupation Army suppressed the peaceful demonstration that took place in Kafr Qaddum village against the continued the closure of the village's entrance for more than ten years.
- The Israeli Occupation Army suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstrations organized by the local Popular Committees against the wall and settlements in Al Walajeh northwest of Bethlehem city. The IOA troops used tear gas bombs and rubber bullets and caused injuries to 3 Palestinians by beating them.

Israeli Settlers Violence

- A number of Israeli settlers attacked a Palestinian family from Al Khader town west of Bethlehem city while they were working in their agricultural lands in Al 'Isawiya area near Eli'zer settlement in the Gust Etzion settlement bloc.

Confiscation and Razing of Lands

- Israeli daily newspaper Haaretz revealed that the Israeli government confiscated privately owned Palestinian lands in the Jordan Valley, and gave the lands to Kibbutz Merav inside the 1949 Green Line (Armistice Line). The Israeli government re-routed the segregation Wall in the area in order to confiscate 1500 dunums of lands owned by the residents of Bardala village, declaring the lands as part of Israel.
