

## Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

4 November 2011

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

## Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli occupation Army arrested Hamza Birnat (18 years old) from Bil'in village west of Ramallah.
- The Israeli occupation Army arrested Abed El Rahman 'Alian (21 years old) after storming his house in Beit Iksa village southwest of Jerusalem city.
- The Israeli occupation Army arrested 7 Palestinian citizens, 3 from Yatta town in Hebron city and 4 from Betounia town in Ramallah.

- Israeli occupation Army raided Salhab family in Al Harayek village south of Hebron and arrested Amjad Salhab (13 years old) and 'Eez ed Deeb Salhab(14 years old). Furthermore, the IOA raided the house of Ahmad Mahmud Al Shamesti arrested his son 'Ala' (21 years old) in Yatta town, causing damage to the furniture.
- The Israeli Occupation Army had suppressed the weekly peaceful demonstrations organized by the local Popular Committees against the Wall and Settlements that took place in Kafr Qaddum in Ramallah governorate. The IOA had used the tear gas and rubber bullets, where dozens of Palestinian residents along with International activists were injured and hospitalized.
