

Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

The Israeli occupation Army arrested Ayoub Mustafa Abu Rayda (25 years old) from Qusra village south of Nablus city after detaining him at one flying checkpoint that was erected by the Army and took him to an unknown destination.

Erection of the Israeli Checkpoints

• The Israeli occupation Army erected a flying military checkpoint at the entrance of Beita village south of Nablus city, and started checking Palestinians' IDs and their cars.
