



Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

12 October 2011

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation soldiers manning Al Container checkpoint east of Bethlehem city arrested Basel Yousef Al Faqeh (22 years old) from Dura town in Hebron city.
- Israeli occupation army attacked Palestinian farmers while harvesting their olive trees in Bi'r Ja'far area in Deir Estyia village west of Salfit Governorate, searched in owner properties of Abed Al Rahman Salman, searched the Identity Cards of the farmers .
- Israeli occupation authorities announced to close the Ibrahimi mosque in Hebron city on Sunday and Monday for jewish holidays

Israeli settlers Violence

- Israeli settlers started razing Palestinian agricultural lands in Qenieh area located between Eskaka and Yasouf towns east of Salfit Governorate and put 4 new caravans in the outpost located south Kfar Tapuah(est. 1978, pop.867). The razed lands are owned by Hamad Allah Yousef Abu Hakmeh, Daoud Abed Al Kader Abu Daher, Abed Al Kader Ahmad Abu Hakma , Ahmad Mahmoud Lami and Ahmad Awad Harb.

Others

- Palestinian cities in the West Bank observed a two-hour commercial strike in solidarity with the Palestinian prisoners who have been on an open hunger strike for 16 days in Israeli prisons.
