



Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

11 October 2011

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli occupation Army raided 'Azzun town east of Qalqilyia Governorate and arrested Mohammad Mothana Hussein(14 years old), Bar'a Qaher Abu Hanieh(14 years old), Mo'awieh Radwan(15 years old) and Tha'er Mahmud Masoud Radwan(17 years old) after storming and searched their houses .
- The Israeli occupation Army prevented students and teachers of Qortuba school Beit Hadasa (Ad Daboya) outpost in the old city of Hebron from entering their school for Jewish holidays.

- The Israeli occupation Army stormed several commercial stores owned by Nedam Khalid Ziad, Sadek Najeeb Awad and Adnan Fares Awad in Kufeirit village south of Jenin city. Also set up military checkpoint at the entrance of Ya'bad village.
- Israeli occupation army arrested Ahmad Abu Hashem, secretary of the Popular Committee against the Wall and Settlements in Beit Ummar village north of Hebron and took him to an unknown destination after storming his house, forcing the family members to leave the house and caused damages to the properties.

Home Demolition and Demolition Threats

- The Israeli bulldozers demolished for the third time the 60 square meters mosque under the pretext of being built in an area classified as closed military area in Khirbet Irza in Al Maleh area in the northern valleys.
- The Israeli bulldozers demolished agricultural barracks owned by Eli Admoun Shehadeh in Beit Jala city.
- The Israeli bulldozers demolished 2 houses made of tin and 2 agricultural rooms under the pretext of building without permits in 'Arab ar-Ramadin Ash Shamali Bedouin community north of Qalqilya Governorate. Where the Israeli Army asked Qader Jabir, the owner of threatened structures day before to remove all the structures otherwise the Israeli bulldozers will do so.

Israeli settlers Violence

- Israeli settlers of Bear 'Illit settlement west Bethlehem Governorate set fire into 35 olive, almonds and figs trees in Al Matabekh area in Nahhalin village southwest Bethlehem city.
- Israeli settlers set fire into olive trees in Palestinian lands in Ras Karkar, Beitlo and Deir 'Ammar villages west Ramallah city.

Others

- The Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has instructed Justice Minister Yaakov Neeman to set up a task force to explore ways to legalize houses in the settlements that were built on private Palestinian land. The instruction was issued under heavy pressure from settlers and others on the right in response to the state's decision to demolish several outposts built on private Palestinian land over the next half year.
