Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 03 April 2016

he daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats the occupied Palestinian territory, in the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed Al Issawiya town in Jerusalem city. Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA, where the IOA fired teargas and stun grenades at Palestinians and their houses. (Raya 3 April 2016)
- Hatim Yassen Abu Mialah (13 years) was injured in his head after the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) fire rubber bullets at him while he was in his way to the school in Ras Al Amoud neighborhood in Silwan

town in Jerusalem city. The IOA also, assaulted and arrested him. (RB2000 3 April 2016)

- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Qalandiya refugee camp, north of Jerusalem city. The IOA used stun grenades to attack Palestinians. During the clashes, the IOA invaded and searched a Palestinian house owned by Khalil Badran. (RB2000 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) seized NIS 1800 from a Palestinian after stopping him at a sudden checkpoint erected by the IOA near Arraba village, southwest of Jenin city. (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) near Joseph tomb, east of Nablus city. (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) tightened its procedures at the entrances of Huwara village, south of Nablus city, and forced a number of Palestinians to close their commercial stores. (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) seized 120 sheep from two Palestinian shepherds; Jehad and Yousif Ismail Mur, while they were in Masafer Yatta areas, east of Yatta town, south of Hebron city. (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) opened fire at Palestinian fishing boats while they were sailing off the shores of the central of Gaza strip. (Wafa 3 April 2016)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned a number of Palestinians to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etzion settlement bloc, after storming their houses in Deir Samit village, west of Hebron city. (RB2000 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Abdalla Mohammad Odeh to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police, after storming his house in Budrus village, northwest of Ramallah city. (RB2000 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested a Palestinian from Yabad town, west of Jenin city, after stopping him at a military checkpoint erected by the IOA at the entrance of Yabad town. As a result, clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA, where the IOA fired teargas and stun grenades at Palestinians. (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians after raiding and searching their houses in Nablus city. The arrestees were identified as: Tawfeq Sabti Dwikat (27 years) and Farouq Dwikat. (Wafa 3 April 2016)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians after raiding his family houses in Beit Fajjar village, south of Bethlehem city. The arrestees were identified as: Muhseen As'ad Thawabtah (20 years) and Mahmoud Khalil Taqatqiah (23 years). (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mahmoud Khalid Ahmed (23 years) after storming and searching his family house in Marah Rabah village, south of Bethlehem city. (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Anas Al 'Adam (24 years) to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etzion settlement bloc, after storming his house Ad-Duhiesha refugee camp, south of Bethlehem city. (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested four Palestinians after storming and searching their houses in Hebron city. The arrestees were identified as: Hamada Khalid Al Ja'bari (20 years), Yousif Abed Al Karem Al Ja'bari (19 years), Mohammad Shukri Shaheen (16 years) and Ahmed Khalid Shahada Ad-Doudi (22 years). The IOA transferred the arrestees to unknown location. (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians from Al Khader village, southwest of Bethlehem city. The arrestees were identified as: Mohammad Nail Hamidah (17 years) and Mohammad Ahmed Salah. (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Adi Ash-Sha'ir (19 years) from Olive mount/ At Tur neighborhood in Jerusalem city. (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Ala Najajrah (25 years) to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etizon settlement bloc, after storming his family house in Nahhalin village, southwest of Bethlehem city. (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Mohammad Waled 'Awidat (23 years) and Younis Suliman Abiyat (26 years) to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etizon settlement bloc, after storming their house in Hindaza village, south of Bethlehem city. (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested a Palestinian after stopping him at Za'tara military checkpoint, south of Nablus city. (Al-Quds 3 April 2016)

Israeli Settler Violence

• Israeli settlers assaulted Nail Khalid Musa Abu Aram (25 years) while he was at Masafer Yatta area, east of Yatta town, south of Hebron city. (Wafa 3 April 2016)

- Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed Al Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city, toured in its courtyard, and tried to perform Talmudic rituals. (Wafa 3 April 2016)
- Israeli settlers living in Yesh Kodesh outpost razed Palestinian land in Jalud village, south of Nablus city. The targeted land is owned by Ahmed Nasser Haj Mohammad. (Wafa 3 April 2016)

Israeli Military Orders

• Israeli High court decided to demolish a Palestinian house in Sur Baher town in Jerusalem city. The targeted house is owned by Abed Ar-Rahman Dwikat. (Al-Quds 3 April 2016)

Expansion of settlements

The Israeli Occupation Authorities (IOA) started implementing a new settlement plan that includes building 1,800 housing units in four illegal settlements east of occupied al-Quds (Jerusalem), Iroshalim weekly newspaper revealed. The paper said that the Israeli municipality allocated nine million shekels for the construction of 1,600 new housing units in clear challenge to the US administration that declared its rejection of the settlement plan nearly six years ago. US Vice President Joe Biden visited Tel Aviv in 2010 to activate the peace process between Palestinians and Israelis. During his visit, the Planning and Construction Committee in occupied Jerusalem announced plans to build 1,600 housing units. Biden had expressed then his country's rejection of the settlement plan causing a media and diplomatic row over the issue. The plan was frozen over the past six years to be revived recently as "a political reaction to the ongoing Jerusalem Intifada," according to the paper. On the other hand, the Israeli Kol Ha'ir newspaper revealed that Euro Israel Company has sold, during February, 12 housing units under construction in Nabi Yacob settlement north of occupied Jerusalem. Nabi Yacob settlement project includes the reconstruction of four nine-storey buildings which consist of 78 new housing units, according to the paper. Iroshalim also revealed that the Israeli municipality's Finance Committee allocated last week 17 million shekels to develop the industrial zone of Atarot northeast of the occupied city. Erection of Israeli checkpoints

• Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) erected a military checkpoint at the entrance of Arraba village in Jenin governorate. The IOA stopped and

searched Palestinian vehicles and checked ID cards. (Wafa 3 April 2016)

Israeli Closures

• Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) closed with iron gate the entrance of Sarra village, south of Nablus city. (Wattan 3 April 2016)

Other

• Israel to bring in 900 Moldovan construction workers. The Population Immigration and Border Authority approves a request to bring to Israel some 900 construction workers from Moldova. Another 6,000 people will be recruited to work for foreign companies working on Israeli construction projects, Israel Radio says. There are currently approximately 7,600 foreign workers employed in construction in Israel. (Time of Israel 3 April 2016)
