Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

15 March 2016

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

The daily report does not necessarily reflect ARIJ's opinion.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed and toured in areas in Al Issawiya town in Jerusalem city. (Safa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) raided and searched tens of Palestinian commercial structures in Ein Al Louza neighborhood in Silwan town in Jerusalem city. (Safa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded and searched a Palestinian house in Rujeib village in Nablus governorate, and questioned the residents. (Safa 15 March 2016)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed and toured in several areas in Deir Samit and Idhna towns in Hebron governorate. (Safa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) surrounded As-Sadeq School in Husan village, west of Bethlehem city, and fired stun and teargas grenades at the students and teachers, causing tens of suffocation cases and the injury of Mohammad Nasser Za'oul. (Wafa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed and searched the campus of Al Khadouri University in Tulkarm city, and confiscated a number of photos, posters and flyers. (Al-Quds 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) staged few meters into the eastern part of Al Khaza'a town, east of Khan Younis city, south of Gaza strip. (Safa 15 March 2016)
- Nahed Fawzi Mteer (24 years) from Qalandiya refugee camp, north of Jerusalem city, died of wounds he sustained during clashes that erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in the camp on the 1st of March 2016. (Al-Quds 15 March 2016)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians after storming and searching their houses in Jabal Al Mukabir town, south of Jerusalem city. The arrestees were identified as: Salah Halsa and Rami Zahaika. (Wafa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mohammad Amjad Qatuni (16 years) from Askar refugee camp and Mohammad Abed Al Hakim Nada (16 years) from Al Ein refugee camp, in Nablus city. (Wafa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested a 16 years old Palestinian girl after stopping her at Za'tara military checkpoint, south of Nablus city. (Maannews 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Bajes Nakhla after storming and searching his house in Al Jalazoun refugee camp, north of Ramallah city. The IOA transferred the arrestee to unknown location. (Safa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Nassar Naser after storming his family house in Dura town in Hebron governorate. (Safa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ahmed Ash-Shahateen after raiding his house in Khursa village, southwest of Hebron city. (Safa 15 March 2016)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Riad An-Namour Musalam An-Namour (48 years) after storming and searching his house in Abu Al 'Asja village, southwest of Hebron city. (Safa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Azz Ad-Diyn Abu Rabee after raiding his house in Al Fawar refugee camp, south of Hebron city. (Safa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians after storming and searching their family houses in Al Arroub refugee camp, north of Hebron city. The arrestees were identified as: Mahmoud Mohammad Jawabrah and Abed Al Karem Mahmoud Abed Al Karem Muhseen. (Safa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mohammad Ibrahim Abu Yabes (14 years) after storming and family house in Husan village, west of Bethlehem city. (Safa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned two Palestinians to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etzion settlement bloc, after storming their houses in Bethlehem city. (Safa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IAO) summoned Ismail Abu Fanour to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police after storming his house in Yatta town, south of Hebron city. (Maannews 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested three Palestinians and summoned two others (Zakariya and Amir Abed Al Mun'em Alan Khatatba) to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police, after storming and searching their houses in Beit Furik village, southeast of Nablus city. Two of the arrestees were identified as: Adi Ziyad Hinni and Ma'rouf Nayef Abu As-Su'oud. (Al-Quds & Safa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ibrahim Abu Shaqra and Adham Abu 'Arqoub (25 years) after storming their houses in Birzeit village, north of Ramallah city. The IOA transferred the arrestees to unknown location. (Al-Quds & Safa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians from Abu Dis town, east of Jerusalem city after stopping them at Az-Zaytouna military checkpoint, east of Jerusalem city. The arrestees were identified as: Enas Said Abu Hilal (25 years) and Wafa Mohammad Odeh Abu Hilal (30 years). (Wafa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Abed Ar-Rahman Said Amro (21 years) after raiding his family house in Rummana village, northwest of Jenin city. (Wafa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Abed Al Halem Mohammad Najajrah (16 years) from Nahhalin village, west of Bethlehem city, while he was near Beta Illit settlement. (Wafa 15 March 2015)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mohammad Abed Al Fatah Damiri from Tulkarm refugee camp, east of Tulkarm city. (Al-Quds 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Waleed Mustafah Hassan Yahya (50 years) after raiding his house in the southern neighborhood of Tulkarm city. (Al-Quds 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested three Palestinians after storming their houses in Kafr Jamal village, south of Tulkram city. The arrestees were identified as: Ibrahim Jaber Ameen Tuba, Abed Ar-Razeq Hussen Tuba and Ali Hussen Mohammad Ali. (Al-Quds 15 March 2016)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

• Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) demolished a structure at the entrance of Qalandiya refugee camp, north of Jerusalem city. (Wafa 15 March 2016)

Israeli Military Orders

- Israeli Municipality of Jerusalem issued an administrative order to demolish a Palestinian house in Ath-Thawri neighborhood in Silwan town in Jerusalem city. The targeted house is owned by Ahmed Abu Sal'oum. (Wafa 15 March 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) handed out the residents of Al Walaja village, west of Bethlehem city, a number of Halt construction orders. Two of the targeted houses is owned by: Ibrahim Nayrokh and Ibrahim Ali Al 'arja. (Al-Quds 15 March 2016)

Confiscation & Razing of lands

• The Government Declares 2342 Dunams South of Jericho as State Land. The Army radio exposed today that on March 10, 2016, during Vice President Biden's visit to Israel, the Civil Administration's Head of the Government Property signed a declaration according to which 2,342 dunams (580 acres) south of Jericho are now government property. This declaration of state land comes two months after it was reported that the Minister of Defense approved a declaration of 1,500 dunams as state lands in an area south of Jericho. It appears that the January approval by the MoD permitted the land declaration which is now being implemented. However, the size of the land declared is larger than what was published in January and includes 2,342 dunams. The declaration, which is in fact a confiscation, was meant for the

expansion of nearby settlements as well as for trade and tourism projects operated by the settlers. This is one of the largest declarations in recent years, and it is another illustration of the government's policy of land confiscation, including those far beyond the green line and the separation barrier.
