Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

11 November 2015

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

The daily report does not necessarily reflect ARIJ's opinion.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) surrounded and stormed Tuqu High School for Boys in Tuqu village, southeast of Bethlehem city. The IOA detained the headmaster of the School; Majed Ash-Sha'ir and threatened him to close the school if the students hurled stones at the IOA. (Al-Quds & RB2000 11 November 2015)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Al Arroub refugee camp, north of Hebron city. The IOA The

- IOA fired teargas grenades at Palestinians and their houses, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Maannews 11 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) opened fire at statue in the yard of a Palestinian house in An-Nabi Saleh village, north of Ramallah city. The targeted house is owned by Abdalla At-Tamimi. (Maannews 11 November 2015)
 - Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Qalandiya refugee camp, north of Ramallah city, and opened fire at a Palestinian, identified as: Faris Abu Al 'Aesha (16 years), he was injured and then the IOA arrested him. As a result, clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA, where the IOA fired live bullets and teargas grenades, causing the injury of 11 Palestinians. During the clashes, the IOA stormed a Palestinian house owned by Mohammad Abed Raboh, and detained his three sons; Nibal, Yasser and Wissam. (Maannews 11 November 2015)
 - Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at Atara military checkpoint, north of Ramallah city. The IOA fired teargas and stun grenades, causing tens of suffocation cases and the injury of two Palestinians. (Wafa 11 November 2015)
 - Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Al Balo' neighborhood, near the DSO military checkpoint, north of Al Bireh city. The IOA fired live and rubber bullets, and teargas grenades, causing the injury of 20 Palestinians, one of them was seriously injured, and dozens of suffocation cases. (Maannews & Al-Quds 11 November 2015)
 - Dozens of Palestinians suffered gas inhalation during clashes that erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Al Jalazoun refugee camp, north of Ramallah city. The IOA used teargas grenades to attack Palestinians. (Al-Quds 11 November 2015)
 - Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) intensified its presence around Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city and in several areas and streets in the old city of Jerusalem. The IOA erected checkpoints at the entrance of the city, stopped Palestinians and checked their ID cars. (Safa 11 November 2015)
 - Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked a non-violent protest at the entrance of Dura town, southwest of Hebron city. The IOA fired rubber bullets and teargas grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases and the injury of a Palestinian. (RB2000 11 November 2015)
 - Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked a non-violent protest in Beit Ummer ton, north of Hebron city. The IOA fired live bullets and stun grenades at participants. The IOA also erected a number of cement bloc at the entrance of the town, where the IOA stopped and assaulted Palestinians. (Maannews 11 November 2015)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) opened fire at Palestinian farmers while they were near the border fence at Bo'rit Abu Samra and site 16, north of Gaza strip. (Al-Quds 11 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) raided and searched two Palestinian houses in Beit Ummer town, north of Hebron city. The targeted houses are owned by: Sami Hassan Mansour Sabarnah and Ahmed Hamed Ahmidan Abu Mariya. (Wafa & Maannews 11 November 2015)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at the northern entrance of Bethlehem city. The IOA fired rubber bullets and teargas grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Wafa 11 November 2015)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested four Palestinians after stopping them at the entrance of Al Issawiya town in Jerusalem city. The arrestees were identified as: As'ad Murad Dari (17 years), Sami Zuhair Al Khateeb (17 years), Mohammad Abed Al Halim Dari (16 years) and Anas Ali Abu Asab (15 years). Noted that the IOA assaulted the arrestees. (SilwanIC 11 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Ahmed Mohamad Darbas to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police, after raiding his family house in Al Issawiya town in Jerusalem city. (Wafa 11 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Malak Othman Qarawi (10 years) from At-Tur town in Jerusalem city. (SilwanIC 11 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded "Silwan Middle School for boys" at Ras Al Amoud neighborhood in Silwan town and arrested a Palestinian student, identified as Jubrail Al 'Awar (16 years), and summoned the headmaster; Salah Al 'Awar, to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police. During the operation, the IOA searched a number of bags owned by the students. (SilwanIC 11 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested three Palestinians after raiding their houses in Ras Al Amoud neighborhood in Silwan town in Jerusalem city. The arrestees were identified as: Muntaser Salamah, Malak Ash-Shwiki and Mohmmad Nasser. (RB2000 11 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Rima Al Maslamani and Rania Al Ghazawi to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police, after

storming their houses in Ath-Thawri neighborhood in Silwan town in Jerusalem city. (Wafa 11 November 2015)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested four Palestinians after raiding their houses in Ad-Dhahiriya town, south of Hebron city. The arrestees were identified as: Nasser Musa Al Hawareen, Nasser Ali Samarah, Mohammad Khalid Abu Alan and Mahmoud Issa Iwridat. (Maannews 11 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians from Beit 'Awa town, west of Hebron city. The arrestees were identified as: Yasser Abed Ar-Rahman Musalam and Ghassan Mahmoud Abed Al Aziz As-Switi. (Maannews 11 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians after storming and searched their houses in Bani Naim town in Hebron governorate. The arrestees were identified as: Salah Mohammad Musa Ajde' (20 years) and Mutasem Ibrahim Ajde' (20 years). (Wafa 11 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians after storming and searching their houses in Husan village, west of Bethlehem city. The arrestees were identified as: Rami Khalil Hamamrah and Mohammad Ziyad Al 'Ardi (17 years). (Al-Quds 11 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Doud Hassan Doud Hamad (18 years) after raiding his family house in Battir village, west of Bethlehem city. The IOA transferred the arrestee to unknown location. (Al-Quds 11 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mohammad Jamel Al 'Amur (12 years) during clashes that erupted between Palestinians and the IOA in Tuqu village, southeast of Bethlehem city. (RB2000 11 November 2015)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city and toured in its courtyard. The IOA prevented the Palestinian women named in the "Black list" from entering the mosque. (Safa 11 November 2015)

Expansion of settlements

- While the prime minister is in the US, Jerusalem's committee for planning and construction is expected to approve on Wednesday the building of 891 new housing units in the neighborhood of Gilo, which is located beyond the Green Line. The plan will see the construction of new homes in an empty area between Gilo and the Palestinian village of Beit Jala. The area is under ownership of several bodies, including the Israel Land Administration and KKL-JNF. In order to issue a building permit, all plots will have to come under one ownership, and then be re-divided. The plan was submitted and approved in 2013, but the planning was stopped as a result of the unofficial construction freeze in Jerusalem. After the committee approves the re-division of the plots, it will essentially green light the project, allowing it to move forward. The Jerusalem municipality said in response: "This is not an approval of construction plans, as the plans have been approved two years ago in a district committee. This is a strictly technical process of correcting the internal borders of the plots." ([Ynetnews](#) 11 November 2015)

Erection of Israeli checkpoints

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) erected military checkpoints at the northern and southern entrance of Hebron city. The IOA stopped and searched Palestinian vehicles and checked ID cards. (Wafa 11 November 2015)

Israeli Closures

- For the seven days in a row, the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) closed the main entrance of Bani Naim town, east of Hebron city. (Wafa 11 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) closed the western entrance of Beit Fajjar village, south of Bethlehem city. (Orient FM 11 November 2015)
