Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 19 January 2016

he daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats the occupied Palestinian territory, in the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed Nahhalin village, west of Bethlehem city. clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA, where the IOA fired teargas grenades and rubber bullets, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Al-Quds 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) raided and toured in several neighborhoods and area in Husan and Beit Fajjar villages in Bethlehem governorate. (Al-Quds 19 January 2016)

• Israeli Occupation bulldozers staged few meters into the eastern part of Al Qarara town, east of Khan Younis city, south of Gaza strip, and razed Palestinian land. (Maannews 19 January 2016)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Murad Abdalla Ad'ees (15 years) after storming his family house in Beit 'Amra village, west of Yatta town in Hebron governorate. (Wafa 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians and summoned Omar Mohammad Musleh Awad (25 years) to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etzion settlement bloc, after storming and searching their houses in Beit Ummer town, north of Hebron city. The arrestees were identified as: Mohammad Awad Badran (18 years) and Amir Mohammad Abed Al Jawad Akhalil (19 years). (Al-Quds 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Ahmed Raid Shanan to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etzion settlement bloc, after raiding his house in Dura town, southwest of Hebron city. (Wafa 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Wissam Odeh after storming his house in Tulkarm city. (Wattan 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested four Palestinians after storming and searching their houses in Yabad town, west of Jenin city. The arrestees were identified as: Khalid Waleed 'Atatrah (22 years), Abdalla Ahmed Harzalla (24 years), Seif Adnan Al Kilani (21 years) and Kamal Mohammad Harzalla (26 years). Noted that during the operation, the IOA invaded and searched tens of Palestinian houses. (ARN 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Jamel Salah 'Amarnah (31 years) after storming his house in Zabda village, west of Jenin city. (ARN 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Omar Samir Shalash (24 years) after storming his family house in Bethlehem city. (Orient FM 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested a Palestinian after stopping him at Huwara military checkpoint, south of Nablus city. (Al-Quds 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinian from Beita village, south of Nablus city. The arrestee were identified as: Zakariya Maher Abed Al Hamed Hamayil (20 years) and Iyhab Shaltaf. (Maannews & Wattan 19 January 2016)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Iyad Nayef Mahmoud Odeh from Huwara village, south of Nablus city. (Maannews 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mohammad Ali Hussen Yassen after storming his house in Asira Al Qibiliya village, south of Nablus city. (Maannews 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) Ahmed Rawad from Azkar refugee camp, east of Nablus city. (Wattan 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Taha Omran Abu Khdeir from Shufat refugee camp, north of Jerusalem city. (Maannews 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians from Jerusalem city. The arrestees were identified as: Mohammad Rashiq (17 years) and Nedal Bazlamet (17 years). (Wafa 19 January 2016)

Israeli Settler Violence

- An Israeli settler living in Mevo Dotan settlement attacked with his vehicle a Palestinian family while they were traveling at the main road near Imreiha village, west of Jenin city. The Israeli settler hit with his vehicle the Palestinian vehicle, causing the injury of 7 family member were inside the vehicle. (Al-Quds 19 January 2016)
- Israeli settlers living in Yetzher settlement hurled stones at Palestinian vehicles while they were crossing Huwara military checkpoint, south of Nablus city. The vehicles were damaged and a number of Palestinians were injured. (Maannews & Al-Quds 19 January 2016)
- Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed Al Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city and toured in its courtyard. (NBPRS 19 January 2016)

Erection of Israeli checkpoints

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) erected military checkpoints at the entrance of Ad-Dhahiriya town and Al Fawar refugee camp in Hebron governorate. The IOA stopped and searched Palestinian vehicles and checked ID cards. (Wafa 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) erected a military checkpoint near Al Fureidis village, southeast of Bethlehem city. (Al-Quds 19 January 2016)

Israeli Closures

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) closed with earth mound the entrance of Janata village, southeast of Bethlehem city. (Wafa 19 January 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Authorities closed Huawar military checkpoint for passing out from Nablus city, starting from the 19th of January 2016 from the early morning to 9:00 a.m. and from 2:30 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. while opening Awarta commercial checkpoint for traffic. (Maannews 19 January 2016)
