## Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

28 November 2015

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

### Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at Huwara military checkpoint, south of Nablus city. The IOA fired rubber bullets and teargas grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Al-Quds 28 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation gunboats opened fire at Palestinian fishing boats while they were sailing at Beit Lahiya shore, north of Gaza strip. (Maannews 28 November 2015)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed a number of Palestinian houses owned the family of a Palestinian martyr; Omar Arafat Az-Za'aqiq, and a mosque in Beit Ummer town, north of Hebron city. The IOA took photos for the house, detained and questioned the residents. As a result, clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA, where the IOA fired live bullets, teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases. Noted that the IOA closed all the entrances of the town and prevented Palestinians from entering or leaving it. (Wafa & RB2000 28 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) forced Palestinian farmers to leave their land, while they were harvesting olive trees, in Burin village, south of Nablus city. (RB2000 28 November 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked the weekly non-violent protest against the segregation wall and settlements in Kafr Qaddum village, east of Qalqiliya city. The IOA fired live and rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades, causing tens of suffocation cases and the injury of a 50 years old Palestinian. (Wafa 28 November 2015)

### **Israeli Arrests**

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested a Palestinian woman after stopping her at Al Hamra military checkpoint, east of Nablus city. (RB2000 28 November 2015)

### **Israeli Settler Violence**

- Israeli settlers attacked Palestinians in Madama village, south of Nablus city, and threatened them. (RB2000 28 November 2015)

### **Expansion of settlements**

- Israeli weekly newspaper "Kool Ha'ir" revealed that the Israeli Municipality of Jerusalem prepared a plan to construct a new road and a roundabout at the entrance of Har Homa settlement. (Al-Quds 28 November 2015)

### **Erection of Israeli checkpoints**

- Israel Occupation Army (IOA) erected a military checkpoint at Al Hawawir area, north of Halhul town, north of Hebron city. The IOA stopped and searched Palestinian vehicles and checked ID cards. (Wattan 28 November 2015)

## **Israeli Closures**

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) closed all the entrance of Bir Nabala village, northwest of Jerusalem city, and a road reach to Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, Beit Iksa, Qatanna and Biddu villages, northwest of Jerusalem city. (Pal Today & Orient FM 28 November 2015)
