Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

19 April 2014

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed and searched a Palestinian house in At-Tayba village, northwest of Jenin city. The targeted house is owned by: Ziyad Ali Jabareen. (Wafa 19 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked a number of Palestinian farmers and shepherds, and prevented them from reaching their land in Um Al-Khair village, east of Yatta town, south of Hebron city. (Wattan 19 April 2014)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) confiscated a Palestinian vehicle near Beit Ummer town, north of Hebron city. During the operation, the IOA stopped and searched a number of Palestinian vehicles and checked ID cards. (Wattan 19 April 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Ayda refugee camp, north of Bethlehem city. The IOA fired teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Wattan 19 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded and toured in several areas in Hebron city. (Wattan 19 April 2014)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinian children while they were at the courtyard of Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city. The arrestees were identified as: Bassam Tareq Abu Sabeh (12 years) and Amir Shahada Al-Malki (11 years). (SilwanIC 19 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mohammad Al-Ja'afrih (20 years) after storming his house in Wadi Al-Qatee' area, east of Tarqumiya village, west of Hebron city. (Wafa 19 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Diya Amjad Al-Rajabi (19 years) after storming and searching his family house in Jabal Johar neighborhood in Hebron city. (Wattan 19 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Adel Mohammad Shawawrih (41 years) and Ahmed Taleeb Al-Dar'awi (26 years) to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etzion settlement bloc, after storming their houses in Ash-Shawawrih village, east of Bethlehem city. (Wattan 19 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested 7 Palestinians after raiding and searching their houses in Jerusalem city. The arrestees were identified as: Firas Abu Ghanim, Amer Al-Bazlamet, Mohamamd Al-Juba, Ahmed Salah, Akram Ash-Shrfah, Ihab Zaghir and Nafid Juba. (Wattan & SilwanIC 19 April 2014)

Erection of Israeli checkpoints

• Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) erected military checkpoints at the entrance of Sair, Halhul, Yatta, and Bani Na'im towns in Hebron governorate. The IOA stopped and searched Palestinian vehicles and checked ID cards. (Wattan 19 April 2014)

Israeli Closures

• Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) closed all the gates of Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city and prevented Palestinian under the age of 50 year from entering Al-Aqsa mosque. (SilwanIC 19 April 2014)
