Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 21 April 2014

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats occupied Palestinian territory, in the the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation warplanes launched several missiles at agricultural land, east of Beit Hanun town, north of Gaza strip. (Safa 21 April 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Awarta village, south of Nablus city. The IOA fired teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (RB2000 21 April 2014)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ahmed Isma'il Safi after storming his house in Ein As-Sultan refugee camp in Jericho city. (Maannews 21 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Fawzi At-Talahmih (37 years) after storming and searching his house in Al-Burj village, southwest of Hebron city. (Safa 21 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Bashar Dana (27 years) after raiding his family house in Hebron city. (Safa 21 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mahmoud Jala Zid (19 years) after storming his family house in Tura village, west of Jenin city. (Wafa 21 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Ala Majed Marqa after to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police after storming his house in As-Samu' village, south of Hebron city. (Wafa 21 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mohammad Tareq Ali As-Sa'di and summoned his brother Tareq and Said Subhi Barghish to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Salem military base, after storming his house in Jenin refugee camp, west of Jenin city. (Wafa 21 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mohammad Salim Ibrahim AS-Sabah (22 years) after storming and searching his house in Tequ village, southeast of Bethlehem city. (Wafa 21 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Amjad Daraghma and assaulted Jamal Khalid Daraghmah after storming Al-Lubban Ash-Sharqiyah village, south of Nablus city. (Maannews 21 April 2014)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli settlers living in Yetzher settlement escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) hurled stones at Palestinian students in Burin village, south of Nablus city. Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the settlers. (Safa 21 April 2014)
- Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city and toured in its courtyard. (NBPRS 21 April 2014)
- Israeli settlers living in Betar Illit settlement hurled stones at Palestinian vehicles while they were traveling near Nahhalin village, southwest of Bethlehem city. A number of Palestinian vehicles were destroyed. (NBPRS 21 April 2014)
- Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed a Palestinian playground in Wadi Fukin village, southwest of Bethlehem city and performed Talmudic rituals. The IOA forced Palestinian children to leave the playground. (NBPRS 21 April 2014)

Erection of Israeli checkpoints

• Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) erected a military checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Einun village, north of Hebron city. The IOA stopped and searched Palestinian vehicles and checked ID cards. (Wafa 21 April 2014)
