# Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

24 April 2014

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \( \) or news sources.

## Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) raided and searched a Palestinian house in Beit Fajjar village, south of Bethlehem city. The targeted house is owned by Mohammad Ibrahim Thawabti. (Raya 24 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation warplanes launched several missiles at Palestinian houses in Beit Lahiya town, north of Gaza strip, causing the injury of 12 Palestinians. (Maannews 24 April 2014)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) intensified its presence at the southern entrance of Ramallah city, at the main entrance of Ar-Ram town and at Qalandyia and Jaba checkpoints. (Al-Quds 24 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation gunboats opened fire at Palestinian fishing boats while they were sailing at As-Sudaniya and Rafah shores in Gaza strip. (Al-Quds 24 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) staged 200 meters at agricultural land, east of Al-Qrara village, east of Khan Younis city, south of Gaza strip, and opened fire at Palestinian houses. (Wafa 24 April 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Al-Far'a refugee camp, north of Nablus city. The IOA fired live and rubber bullets and teargas grenades at Palestinians, causing the injury of Jehad Idris Hassan (23 years). During the clashes, the IOA arrested Yousif Jaber Abu Siyam (23 years) after storming his house in the camp. (Maannews 24 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded and searched several areas in Jaba village, south of Jenin city. (Wafa 24 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) raided and toured in Jalbun village, east of Jenin city and took photos for a number of houses. (Wafa 24 April 2014)

### Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians after storming and searching their houses in An-Nabi Saleh village, north of Ramallah city. The arrestees were identified as: Rayan Othman At-Tamimi (35 years) and Mohammad Wajeh At-Tamimi (19 years). During the operation, the IOA fired stun grenades at Palestinian houses. Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA, where the IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades. (RB2000 24 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ra'fat Mustafah Mohammad Awad (16 years) from Beit Ummer town, north of Hebron city, while he was interviewing the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etzion settlement bloc. (Wattan 24 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested eight Palestinians after raiding and searching their houses in Deir Samit village, west of Hebron city. The arrestees were identified as: Jehad Isma'il Sharwnah (35 years), Mohammad Abu Harbid (20 years), Wael Hassan Abd Al-Jawad Al-Hroub (35 years), Daoud Abd Al-Wahab Abd Al-Aziz (32 years), Musa Ali Hassan Al-Hroub (32 years), Azzam Al-Awawda (22 years), Ra'fat Al-Awawda (24 years) and Munir Mohammad Al-Awawda (50 years). The IOA transferred the arrestees to unknown location. During the

- operation, the IOA invaded and searched several Palestinian houses, and questioned the residents. The IOA closed all the entrances of the village, and prevented Palestinians from leaving or entering the village. (Raya 24 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested five Palestinians after storming and searching their houses in Osarin village, south of Nablus city. The arrestees were identified as: Mohammad Adili, Fadil Adili, Rami Bassam Najeeb, Musleh Hatim Arif, and Ihab Ameer Izzat Adili. (Wafa 24 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Salam Faiz Mufleh (18 years) from Osarin village, south of Nablus city, after stopping him at Al-Karama terminal, while he was traveling to Jordan. (Maannews 24 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested a Palestinian while he was near the Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron. (Al-Quds 24 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Navy arrested two Palestinian fishermen while they
  were sailing at Gaza shore, northwest of Gaza strip. The arrestees were
  identified as: Adi Abd Al-Bari Al-Sultan (20 years) and Hamuda Ali
  Zaiyed (15 years). (Sama News 24 April 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Mahmoud Abd Al-Karem Sidqi to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Salem military base, after storming his house in Anza village, south of Jenin city. (Wafa 24 April 2014)

#### Other

- Israeli organizations send a document to the Israeli Prime Minster "Benjamin Netanyahu" asked him to pay NIS 10,000 to each Israeli Jew, prevented to storm Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem to celebrate "Passover holidays", and called him to open all the entrances of Al-Aqsa mosque in the face of the Israeli. (NBPRS 24 April 2014)
- Al-Aqsa foundation for Al-Wqaf and Heritage declared that the Israeli bulldozers started the construction of a Synagogue for women nearby the western wall of Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city. (ARN 24 April 2014)
- Netanyahu: Abbas chose Hamas over peace with Israel. Israel nixes negotiators' meet after Fatah, Hamas sign deal; Abbas: Unity does not contradict peace talks; announcement comes amid Israeli attack on Gaza terrorist, rockets fired at south. Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu decided Wednesday to cancel the scheduled meeting between Israeli peace negotiators and their Palestinian counterparts in wake of the reconciliation agreement signed hours earlier between

rival Hamas and Fatah parties. Netanyahu slammed the agreement and said: "Abu Mazen (Abbas) could have chosen peace with Israel instead of peace with a murderous terror organization. Tonight, while talks are ongoing to extend peace talks, he chose Hamas... He who chooses Hamas does not want peace." Abbas for his part claimed the deal did not contradict the Soon after the unity deal was announced, Israel Air Force jets fired on a suspected Palestinian he rode his motorcycle in the northern Gaza Strip, however they missed their target and wounded at least 12 bystanders in Gaza.
