Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 05 August 2014

 \mathbf{T} he daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats occupied Palestinian territory, in the the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Beir Ayoub, Ein Al-Louza, Batten Al-Hawa, Ath-Thawri and Ras Al-Amoud neighborhoods in Silwan town in Jerusalem city. The IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades at Palestinians, vehicles and houses, causing the injury of a Palestinian. (SilwanIC 5 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed several Palestinian houses and toured at the eastern neighborhoods in Nablus city. The IOA fired

teargas and stun grenades at Palestinians and houses. (Safa 5 August 2014)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Ayda refugee camp, north of Bethlehem city, and occupied the roofs of a number of Palestinian houses. Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA, where the IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases and the injury of 18 people. During the operation, the IOA arrested Abd Al-Rahman Rashed Abu Srour and summoned Hussen Saleh Abu Akir (21 years) and Ibrahim Yasen Abu Srour (20 years) to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etzion settlement bloc. (Wafa & Al-Quds 5 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) prevented Palestinians under the age of 50 from entering Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city. The IOA erected several checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and near Al-Aqsa gates. Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA at the entrance of Al-Aqsa mosque. (Wafa & Paltoday 5 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) raided and destroyed a Palestinian house in Al-Far'a refugee camp, south of Tubas city. The targeted house is owned by Musa Aliyan. Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA, where the IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades at Palestinians, causing dozens of suffocation cases and the injury of a Palestinian. (Al-Quds 5 August 2014)

Gaza strip

- Two children were killed Monday evening in an Israeli airstrike on Rafah, with at least 21 Palestinians killed across the besieged enclave during the day. Mohammad Amjad Oweida, 12, and Amal Amjad Oweida, 5, were killed after an Israeli airstrike hit their house in the al-Barazil neighborhood in Rafah while they were playing on a rooftop. Gaza health ministry spokesman Ashraf al-Qidra said 32 bodies were recovered on Monday and at least 21 Palestinians reported killed. (Maannews 5 August 2014)
- Palestinian medical crews found the bodies of two Palestinian martyrs under the rubble of their houses at Juhr Ad-Dik area, east of Gaza city. (Maannews 5 August 2014)
- Palestinian medical crews found the bodies of two Palestinian martyrs in agricultural land at Karm Abu Mu'amar area, east of Rafah city, south of Gaza strip. (Wafa 5 August 2014)
- Faiz Ismail Abu Hamad (34 years) died of wound he sustained during the Israeli airstrikes hit Palestinian houses in Khan Younis city, south of Gaza strip, few days ago. (Maannews 5 August 2014)

- Salah Ahmed Al-Ghwiti (22 years) died of wound he sustained during the Israeli airstrikes hit Palestinian houses in Rafah city, south of Gaaza strip few hours ago. (Maannews 5 August 2014)
- Israel on Tuesday completed the withdrawal of all troops from Gaza as a 72-hour humanitarian truce went into effect following intense global pressure to end the bloody offensive. The 72- hour humanitarian truce started on the 5th of August 2014 at 8:00 a.m. (Maannews 5 August 2014)
- Palestinian medical crews found the bodies of two Palestinian martyrs under the rubble of their houses at the eastern part of Deir Al-Balah town in the central of Gaza strip. One of the martyrs was identified as: Ahmed Al-Kurd. The Medical crews also found the bodies of 5 Palestinians martyrs under the rubble of their houses in several areas in Gaza strip. (Wafa 5 August 2014)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested four Palestinians after storming and searching their family houses in Jenin refugee camp, west of Jenin city. The arrestees were identified as: Mahmoud Jamel Mohammad Hussen (25 years), Razeen Bilal Ad-Damij (20 years), Mahmoud Jamel Abu Al-Kamil (21 years) and Mohammad Fawzi Ad-Damij (20 years) (Wafa & RB2000 5 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ghassan Ibrahim Zawahra (33 years) from Ad-Dhuheisheh refugee camp, south of Bethlehem city, after stopping him at An-Nashash checkpoint, at the southern entrance of Al-Khader village in Bethlehem governorate. The IOA transferred the arrestee to unknown. (Wafa 5 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Um Tareq Abu Maialah from Jerusalem city after stopping her at Nilin checkpoint. (SilwanIC 5 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested 27 Palestinians from several areas in Jerusalem city. (Wafa 5 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested a Palestinian woman after stopping her at Huwara military checkpoint, south of (Wattan 5 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Qusi Ayman At-Titi after storming and searching his house in Al-Fawar refugee camp, south of Hebron city. (Wafa 5 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Mohammad Iyad and Murad Amro while they were at Ash-Shalal Street in Hebron city. The IOA also summoned Sharef Shawer and Imad Kharwat to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police, after storming their houses in Hebron city.

During the operation, the IOA invaded and searched four Palestinian houses. The targeted houses are owned by: Ashraf Al-Qawasmi, Nasser Al-Qawasmi, Shafiq Al-Juba and Dawik family. (Wafa 5 August 2014)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Mohammad Abd Al-Aziz Al-Rjoub to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police after raiding his house in Dura town, west of Hebron city. (Wafa 5 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ahmed Radei Shousha (27 years) and his brother Mahmoud (25 years) after raiding and searching their house in Husan village, west of Bethlehem city. (Wafa 5 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mohammad Awad Musa Awad (18 years) after storming his family house in Jabal Al-Mawaleh area in Bethlehem city. (Wafa 5 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Mohammad Foud Al-'Adaween (24 years) and his brother Ibrahim (19 years) to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etzion settlement bloc, after storming their house in Azza refugee camp, north of Bethlehem city. (Wafa 5 August 2014)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) demonstrated in Wadi Hilwah neighborhood in Silwan town in Jerusalem city. The Israeli settlers tried to attack Palestinian houses. As a result, clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA, where the IOA fired teargas and stun grenades at Palestinians. (SilwanIC 5 August 2014)
- Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) performed Talmudic rituals at Souq Al-Qataneen in the old city of Jerusalem, which is near to Al-Aqsa mosque. (Wafa 5 August 2014)
- Israeli settlers assaulted and injured Hisham Hassan Mohammad Hasasnah (20 years), from Al-Ubidiya town in Bethlehem governorate, while he was working in Jerusalem city. (Wafa 5 August 2014)
