Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

30 August 2014

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded and searched several Palestinian houses in Yatta and Ad-Dhahiriya towns in Hebron governorate. (RB2000 30 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed and searched dozens of Palestinian houses in Al-Ubidiya town, east of Bethlehem city. (Al-Quds 30 August 2014)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned dozens of Palestinians; one of them identified as Loay Muhie Ash-Sharwana, to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police, after raiding their houses in Deir Samit village, west of Hebron city. (RB2000 30 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mustafah Abd Al-Hafid Tamimi (27 years) and his brother Qadri (20 years) after storming their house in Deir Nidham village, north of Ramallah city. The IOA transferred the arrestees to unknown location. (Maannews 30 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Mashhour Shahir Diriya, Imad Sami Taqatqih, and Ali Fouad Diriya to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etzion settlement bloc, after storming their houses in Beit Fajjar village, south of Bethlehem city. (RB2000 30 August 2014)
