Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

04 August 2014

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed and searched a Palestinian commercial store in Beit Sahour town, east of Bethlehem city, and confiscated security cameras. The targeted store is owned by Musa Jubran. (RB2000 4 August 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at the courtyard of Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city, after the IOA stormed the courtyard of the mosque to evacuate it from Palestinians. The IOA fired teargas and stun grenades causing dozens

of suffocation cases and the injury of others. At the same time, groups of Israeli settlers stormed the mosque and toured in its courtyard. (Wafa 4 August 2014)

- An Israeli Occupation Arm (IOA) opened fire at a Palestinian driver in Ash-Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood in Jerusalem city and killed him. (Maannews 4 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) opened fire at Issam Nizar Jamal Abu As-Sisan from 'Illar village, northeast of Tulkarm city, while he was at the entrance of Deir Ghusun village. (Maannews 4 August 2014)

Gaza Strip

- Two Palestinian were killed after the Israeli warplanes launched a missile at a group of Palestinian, while they were at an area, east of Khan Younis city, south of Gaza strip. The martyrs were identified as: Mahmoud Zaki Al-Laham and Mohammad Al-Astal. (Wafa 4 August 2014)
- Fadi Abd Al-Karem Madi (26 years) was killed after the Israeli warplanes launched a missile at him while he was at Masbah area, east of Rafah city, south of Gaza strip. (Wafa 4 August 2014)
- A Palestinian was killed and three others were injured after the Israeli missiles hit a group of Palestinian in Gaza city. (Wafa 4 August 2014)
- 6 Palestinians were killed after an Israeli airstrike attacked a group of Palestinians in Ash-Sheikh Radwan neighborhood in Gaza city. Four of the martyrs were identified as: Ahmed Maqat, Hamad Maqat, Zahir An-Nasha, Mohammad Al-Madhoun (23 years), Ahmed Banat (22 years) and Suliman Ma'ruf. (Raya & Sama News 4 August 2014)
- A Palestinian was killed and two others were injured after the Israeli warplanes launched a missile at a Palestinian house in Ash Shat'a refugee camp, west of Gaza city. (Sama News 4 August 2014)
- Sixteen Palestinians have been killed in attacks on Gaza since midnight on the 28th day of Israel's offensive on the Strip, a health official said Monday. Health ministry spokesman Ashraf al-Qidra said in a statement that the death toll in Gaza since the beginning of the assault had risen to 1,822. The lethal attacks came ahead of an Israeli-announced humanitarian ceasefire that was to begin at 10:00 a.m and continue until 5:00 p.m across the Strip, except for areas east of Rafah. Israel announced the limited ceasefire after one carrying out a bloody and sustained assault on Rafah from air, land, and sea, leaving some 200 Palestinians dead in 26 hours, according to the Ministry of Health. The announcement also comes after an UN school sheltering 3,000 people was hit by an Israeli strike on Sunday, killing at least 10. Just before the beginning of the lull, Israeli strikes killed two Palestinians in

al-Qarara north of Deir al-Balah. Before that, teenager Raghad Masood was killed and eight of her family members were injured in a shelling on a house in Rafah. Israeli warplanes also targeted a group of Palestinians near Haifa Mosque in Tal al-Zaatar refugee camp in the northern Gaza Strip, killing five and injuring several others. The ministry of health identified those who were killed in the attack as Hamada Khalil al-Qaq, Ahmad Khalid al-Qaq, Suleiman Muhammad Maroof, Zahir al-Anqah, and Izz Addin Abu Tueima. Earlier on Monday morning, the Islamic Jihad movement announced that Danial Mansour, a field leader of its military wing, was killed by an Israeli strike on a house in Jabaliya in the northern Gaza Strip. Another Islamic Jihad fighter, Abd al-Nasser al-Ajouri, was killed in the same raid. Other Palestinians succumbed to wounds sustained in earlier attacks. According to the Ministry of Health, the Israeli offensive on Gaza has left 1,822 Palestinians dead, including 398 children. Some 9,370 Palestinians have been injured, 2,744 of them children. Approximately 373,000 children are in need of psychological support as a result of the trauma of the war, according to UN figures. Over a quarter of Palestinians in Gaza have been forced to leave their homes throughout the assault. (Maannews 4 August 2014)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians after storming and searching their houses in Biddya village, northwest of Salfit city. The arrestees were identified as: Jamel and Issa Ibrahim Odeh. (Wafa 4 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested 12 Palestinians from Jerusalem city. (Wafa 4 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians from Um Ar-Rihan village, west of Jenin city, after stopping them at the main entrance of the village. The arrestees were identified as: Mahmoud Abd Al-Fatah Ziyed (27 years) and his brother Suliman (25 years). (Wafa 4 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested three Palestinians from Qabatyia village, south of Jenin city. The arrestees were identified as: Muhannad Abd Al-Aziz, Mohammad Hassan Abu Al-Rub and Mohammad Ali Abu Al-Rub. (Al-Quds & Wafa 4 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ahmed Youif Hassan Akhalil (27 years) from Beit Ummer town, north of Hebron city after stopping him at a sudden checkpoint erected by the IOA at the entrance of Idhna town. (Wafa 4 August 2014)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested 6 Palestinians after raiding and searching their houses in Beit Ummer town, north of Hebron city. The arrestees were identified as: Kifah Ahmed Youis Bahar (31 years), Mohammad Bahar (30 years), Younis Bahar (25 years), Yousif Khalil Suliman Sabarnih (20 years) and Hisham Fathi Khadir Sabarnih (21 years). (Raya 4 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians after storming their houses in Ayda refugee camp, north of Bethlehem city. The arrestees were identified as: Mahmoud Mohammad Hamad (18 years) and Mahmoud Taisir Al-Mashaikh (20 years). (Raya 4 August 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested 5 Palestinians from Al-Mazra'a Ash-Sharqiya village, north of Ramallah city. The arrestees were identified as: Najdat Qahir Zein (17 years), Mohammad Nafiz Hijaz (12 years), Nidal Ahmed Abd Al-Baqi (15 years), Imad Abd Al-Wahab (16 years) and Abd Al-Basset Ahmed Hijaz (17 years). (Wafa 4 August 2014)
