Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

12 July 2014

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at Bab Az-Zawiya area in Hebron city. The IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases, and the injury of others. (Wafa 12 July 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Beit Einun village, north of Hebron city. The IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Wafa 12 July 2014)

- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at Khursa crossroad in Dura town, west of Hebron city. The IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases and the injury of others. (Wafa 12 July 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Beit Ummer town and Al-Arroub refugee camp, north of Hebron city. The IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Wafa 12 July 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Al-Fawar refugee camp, south of Hebron city. The IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Wafa 12 July 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Idhna town, west of Hebron city. The IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases, and the injury of others. (Wafa 12 July 2014)
- Four Palestinians were injured and dozens suffered gas inhalation during clashes that erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Halhul town, north of Hebron city. The IOA fired live bullets and teargas grenades. (Wafa 12 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Barta'a Ash-Sharqiya village, west of Jenin city and fired teargas and stun grenades a Palestinians, causing dozens of suffocation cases. During the operation, the IOA arrested Mu'tasem Jad Sabri Jad (28 years). (Wafa 12 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed and searched Palestinian houses in Tequ village, southeast of Bethlehem city. The IOA closed all the entrances of the village and declared it as "close military zone". Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA). (Bnews 12 July 2014)

Gaza Strip:

- Three Palestinians killed after Israeli Occupation warplanes launched missiles at a Palestinian park in At-Tufah neighborhood in Gaza city. The three Palestinians were identified as: Ibrahim Hamada, Hassan Ahmed Abu Ghoush and Ahmed Mazen Al-Bal'awi. The Israeli warplanes also, launched missiles at an area in Ash-Shuja'iya and Az-Zaytoun neighborhoods in Gaza city. At An-Nasr Street, the Israeli warplanes launched a missile and killed a Palestinian identified as Anas Qandel (17 years) (Maannews 12 July 2014)
- Three Palestinians; Nabel Basal, Mohammad Halabi and Rif'at As-Sayoti were killed after an Israeli missiles hit an area, west of Gaza city. (Maannews 12 July 2014)

- Israeli Occupation warplanes launched missiles at Al-'Atatra area and As-Sahwa organization, north of Gaza strip. (Maannews 12 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation warplanes launched missiles at a Palestinian house in Khan Younis city, south of Gaza strip. The targeted house was completely destroyed and owned by Makhamir family. The Israeli warplanes also, launched missiles at the offices of Islamic National Bank and Al-Islah organization. (Maannews 12 July 2014)
- Two Palestinians were killed and dozens were injured after an Israeli airstrike attack a Palestinian organization in Beit Lahiya town, north of Gaza strip. (Maannews 12 July 2014)
- In Rafah city, the Israeli warplanes launched missiles at a Palestinian house in Tal As-Sultan neighborhood in the city. Four Palestinians were injured. The targeted house is owned by Tamraz family. (Maannews 12 July 2014)
- Israeli warplanes attacked with missiles a Palestinian house in Beit Hanun town, north of Gaza strip. The targeted house is owned by Zawidi family. (Maannews 12 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation warplanes launched missiles at an area in Abbsan town, east of Khan Younis city. (Wafa 12 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation warplanes launched missiles at a Palestinian house in An-Nasirat refugee camp in the central of Gaza strip. (Wafa 12 July 2014)
- More than 20 Israeli airstrikes attacked several areas in Deir Al-Balah town and Rafah city, south of Gaza strip. (Wafa 12 July 2014)
- Five Palestinians were injured after an Israeli airstrike attacked a Palestinian house in Jabaliya town, north of Gaza strip. (Wafa 12 July 2014)
- Israeli missiles completely destroyed a Palestinian house in Tal Az-Za'tar aream north of Gaza strip. The targeted house is owned by Shawqi 'Afana. (Wafa 12 July 2014)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Yousif Ribhi At-Tarwa from Sair town, south of Hebron city. (Wafa 12 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Hussam, Hassan and Mohammad Al-Qawasmi in Hebron city. The IOA transferred the arrestees to unknown location. (Wafa 12 July 2014)
