Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 28 July 2014

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats occupied Palestinian territory, in the the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers against Palestinian violence civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Dozens of Palestinians suffered gas inhalation during clashes that erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Ayda refugee camp, north of Bethlehem city. The IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades at Palestinians. (Wafa 28 July 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Tequ village and at Qabir Hilwa area in Bethlehem governorate. (Wafa 28 July 2014)

- A Palestinian was injured and Abd Al-Fatah Birnat (55 years) was arrested during clashes that erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Bilin village, west of Ramallah city. (Wafa 28 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked Palestinians while they were visiting the cemetery in Beit Ummer town, north of Hebron city. (Wafa 28 July 2014)
- Three Palestinians were injured and dozens suffered gas inhalation during clashes that erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at the northern entrance of Yatta town, south of Hebron city. The IOA fired live bullets and teargas grenades. (Wafa 28 July 2014)

Gaza Strip:

- Israeli Occupation warplanes launched missiles at a Palestinian park in Ash-Shat'I refugee camp in Gaza city, while they were more than 50 Palestinian children playing in the park. As a result, 10 Palestinian children were killed and others were injured. (Wattan 28 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation warplanes launched missiles at the Outpatient in Ash-Shifa' Hospital in Gaza city. Three Palestinian children were killed and more than 40 others were injured. (Wattan 28 July 2014)
- Palestinian Medical crews found the bodies of three Palestinian martyrs under their demolished houses in Az-Zaytoun neighborhood in Gaza city. (Wafa 28 July 2014)
- Ibrahim Qashta died after he was injured during an Israeli airstrike attacked Rafah city, south of Gaza strip, four days ago. (Wafa 28 July 2014)
- In Khan Younis city: a Palestinian died after she was wounded few days ago after an Israeli airstrike attacked Bani Suhaila town. The Palestinian Medical crews found the bodies of 12 Palestinian martyrs in Al-Khaza'a town. (Wafa 28 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation warplanes launched missiles at a Palestinian house in At-Tuffah neighborhood in Gaza city. A Palestinian old woman was injured. (Wafa 28 July 2014)
- Sameh Jubrail Junid (4 years) was killed after an Israeli airstrikes targeted Abu Safiya area, east of Jabaliya town in Gaza strip. In Jabliay town also, Mohammad Abu Louz was killed after an Israeli missile his house.(Wafa 28 July 2014)
- At least 26 were killed and 241 injured across the Gaza Strip on Monday night as Israel resumed its bombardment of the Gaza Strip from air, land, and sea. Talks for a ceasefire, meanwhile, appeared stillborn after Israeli Prime Minister warned in a speech that the

campaign could last long, even as Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas rushed to Cairo to meet with Hamas representatives. The renewed evening assault brought the total of Palestinians killed Monday to 44, while another 12 bodies were recovered from the rubble by medical teams earlier in the day. Gaza Ministry of Health Spokesman said over the last 21 days, a total of 1,088 Palestinians have been killed and 6,470 have been injured. Of the dead, 251 have been children and 50 have been elderly, while 1,980 children and 259 elderly have been among the injured. The figures include 10 people who were killed on Monday following an Israeli air strike on a children's playground in al-Shati refugee camp in the afternoon, where family outings to celebrate the first day of the Muslim Eid al-Fitr holiday ended in horror with eight children among the dead. Eyewitnesses told Ma'an that children had been wearing clothes given to them as gifts for the Eid and many families had chosen to take advantage of a relative lull in the 21-day assault to head to the park in the seaside neighborhood where the strike occurred. The deaths continue: Ministry of Health Spokesman Ashraf al-Qidra provided a continuing toll of the deaths and injuries across the Gaza Strip Monday night and Tuesday morning. The deaths and injuries are provided here in chronological order, with the most recent as the latest. Six Palestinians were killed in airstrike on two homes in the central Gaza Strip. He named the victims as Ramzy Hossein al-Far, 68, Salam Muhammad al-Far, 59, Issa Kamel Musa, 62, Abd al-Samad Mahmoud Ahmad Ramadan, 16, Ayman Adnan Musa Shokr, 25, and Azza Abd al-Karim al-Haman al-Falleit, 44. Fayeza Ahmad al-Futtah, 59, succumbed to wounds she received earlier in the day in Jabaliya. Ali Hassan Hassan al-Huwwari, 31, died as a result of wounds received on July 21. Mahmoud Abd al-Jalil Abu Kwik, 31, and five others were injured in Gaza City. Five Palestinians were killed and 20 injured in a strike near the Islamic University in Khan Younis. The dead were identified as Muhammad Jumaa Shaat, 30, Muhammad Fadhel al-Agha, Ahmad Nader al-Agha, Marwa Nader al-Agha, Dalia Nader al-Agha. Five were also killed and 20 injured in an Israeli strike on Khan Younis, which killed Najy Ahmad al-Raqqab, 19, Ramy Khaled al-Raqqab, 35, Mahmoud Osama al-Qosas, Shadi Abd al-Kareem Farwana, Mustafa Abd al-Samiee al-Ubadala. Five were killed, including three children elderly, and 50 were injured in shelling in Jabaliya. The dead were identified as Maryam Khalil Ruba, 70, Hani Abu Khalifah, a child named Yusef Emad Qaddoura, a child named Huna Emad Qaddoura, and another child named Muhammad Musa Alwan. 18 were injured in strikes across the central and northern Gaza Strip. 15 injured, mostly children, in an Israeli strike on Sheikh Radwan. Yahiya Mohammad Abdullah al-Aqqad, 49, was killed and three more injured in a strike on al-Fakhari. (Maannews 28 July 2014)

First day of Al-Fetir Holiday, Israel killed more 54 Palestinians. In Khan Younis city: nine Palestinians were killed and 20 others were injured after an Israeli warplane launched a missile at a group of Palestinian near Islamic University. The martyrs were identified as: Mohammad Jum'a Sha't (30 years), Mohammad Fadil Al-Agha (30 years), Ahmed Al-Agha, Marwa Al-Agha, Dalia Al-Agha, Mahmoud Al-Qasas, Shadi Farwniah, Naje Ahmed Al-Raqib (19 years) and Rami Khalid Al-Raqib (35 years). In Al-Qarar town in Khan Tounis city, Mustafa Al-'adele was killed after the Israeli warplanes launched missiles at his house. In Gaza city: Israeli Occupation warplanes launched missiles at an agricultural land in Al-Jala' area in Gaza city, as a result, Mahmoud Abd Al-Jalel Abu Kwik (31 years) was killed and five others were injured. Al-Maghazi refugee camp: three Palestinians were killed after an Israeli airstrike attached their house. The martyrs were identified as: Issa, Mussa, Salem and Ramzi Al-Far. In the central of Gaza strip: Abd Al-Samid Mahmoud Ahmed Ramadan (16 years) was killed during the Israeli airstrikes targeted houses. In Jabliay town: Medical crews declared that two Palestinians died in the hospital after they were injured in an Israeli airstrike attacked their houses in Jabliya town. The martyrs were identified as: Fiza Ahmed Abd Al-Fatah An-Nadi (59 years) and Ali Hassan AL-Hawari (31 years). Five Palestinians were killed and more than 50 others were injured after the Israeli warplanes launched missiles at several areas in Jabliya town. The martyrs were identified as: Mariam Khalil Abd Rabu (70 years), Hani Abu Khalifah, Yousif Qadowra, Hind Imad Qadowra and Mohammad Musa Alwan. (Maannews 28 July 2014)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested three Palestinians after storming Yatta town, south of Hebron city. The arrestees were identified as: Thair Abd Harb Al-Harini (28 years), Issa and Mohammad Talab Abu Fanus. The IOA transferred the arrestees to unknown location. (Wattan & Wafa 28 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested seven Palestinians after storming and searching their houses in Nahhalin village, west of Bethlehem city. The arrestees were identified as: Hassan Mohammad Najar (16 years), Ghaith Mohammad Abed Najar (16 years), Mohammad Fanun (16 years), Ibrahim Hassan Shakarnih (17 years),

Mahmoud Adel Abd As-Salam (18 years), Muntasir Shakarnih (19 years) and Bara' Hilmi Ghaidth (21 years). (Wafa 28 July 2014)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested five Palestinians and an International activist from Tal Al-Ramida neighborhood in Hebron city. The arrestees were identified as: Marwa Amir Abu Shkhidem (19 years), Nujud Majed Abu Shkhidem (18 years), Mohammad Samir Abu Shkhidem (22 years), Ihab Ghanim (40 years) and Sarah Ihab Ghanim (13 years). Note that the IOA arrested the tree girls after an Israeli settler assaulted them. (Maannews 28 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Islam Mohammad Rateb Zahdah (23 years) while he was at Wadi Al-Huseen area in Hebron city. (Maannews 28 July 2014)

Israeli Closures

 Israel Occupation Army (IOA) closed with cement blocks the main entrance of Al-Janiya village, northwest of Ramallah city. The IOA prevented Palestinians from entering or leaving the village. Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA, where the IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Wafa 28 July 2014)
