Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 10 July 2014

 \mathbf{T} he daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats occupied Palestinian territory, in the the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed Abu Dis town, east of Jerusalem city and attacked a Palestinian non-violent protest. The IOA fired teargas and stun grenades at participants. Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA. (Quds Net 10 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) forced Aymen Sa'di Mohammad Odeh Bahar (25 years) to take off his clothe after stopping him at a sudden checkpoint erected by the IOA near Beit Ummer town, north of Hebron city. (Wafa 10 July 2014)

- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at the northern entrance of Bethlehem city. The IOA fired teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases (Wafa 10 July 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at Bab Az-Zawiya area in Hebron city. The IOA fired teargas grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases, and the injury of two Palestinian journalists; Sari Al-'Awiwi and Iyad Al-Hashlamun. (Wafa & Raya 10 July 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Beit Ummer town, north of Hebron city. The IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases, and the injury of two people. (Wafa 10 July 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at Wadi Al-Jouz area, at the entrance of Bani Na'im town, east of Hebron city. The IOA fired live bullets, teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases and the injury of Abdalla Musa Issa Tarirah (29 years). (Wafa 10 July 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Khura village, southwest of Hebron city. The IOA fired teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Wafa 10 July 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Al-Arroub refugee camp, north of Hebron city. The IOA fired teargas and stun grenades at Palestinians and houses, causing dozens of suffocation cases, and the evacuation of two houses. During the clashes, the IOA assaulted and injured Islam Abu Raya (22 years) after stopping him at the entrance of the camp. (Wafa 10 July 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Al-Walaja village, northwest of Bethlehem city. The IOA fired metal bullets, teargas and stun grenades at Palestinians, causing dozens of suffocation cases and the injury of a Palestinian. (Wafa 10 July 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Beit 'Awa town, west of Hebron city. The IOA fired teargas and stun grenades at Palestinians and houses, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Wafa 10 July 2014)
- Palestinian Centre for Human Rights in Gaza strip (PCHR), published the report "Israeli Offensive on Gaza Continues for the Second Consecutive Day": Houses Destroyed While Residents inside; Palestinian Deaths Rise to 22, Including 6 Children 3 Women, and 255

Wounded, Including 107 Children and 64 Women; and 29 Houses Destroyed. In the course of the Israeli offensive on the Gaza Strip that has been ongoing for the second consecutive, Israeli warplanes and gunboats launched intensive attacks throughout the Gaza Strip, targeting houses, civilian facilities, members and training sites of armed groups. From Tuesday noon, 08 July 2014, up to 10:00 on Wednesday, 09 July 2014, 22 Palestinians have been killed, 17 of whom are civilians, including 6 children and 3 women. Eights of these victims, including 6 children, were killed in a house that was targeted by Israeli warplanes, and 6 victims, including 3 women, were killed in front of their house that was targeted by Israeli warplanes. Israeli warplanes have launched 343 airstrikes using 429 missiles on targets throughout the Gaza Strip. The latest developments since the press release issued by PCHR yesterday noon, 08 July 2014, have been as follows: **Rafah:** Israeli warplanes have launched 95 airstrikes using 130 missiles targeting houses, agricultural plots, open areas, tunnels at the Egyptian border and training sites of Palestinian armed groups in the southern Gaza Strip town of Rafah. Israeli ground and naval forces have also fired dozens of shells at various areas in the city. As a result of these attacks, Abdul Hadi Jum'a al-Soufi, 24, a member of a Palestinian armed group, was killed and 26 Palestinians were wounded, including 10 children and 6 women. Additionally, 7 houses belonging to the families of al-Sha'er, al-Masri, al-Ra'ei, al-Barahma, Mansour and al-Hams were destroyed. Khan Yunis: Israeli warplanes have launched 74 airstrikes using 80 missiles targeting 9 houses, 2 minarets of mosques, an agricultural plot and paramilitary sites in the southern Gaza Strip town of Khan Yunis. The attack on a house, around and inside which dozens of Palestinian civilians gathered, killed 8 civilians, including 6 children, and wounded 28 others, including 19 children and a woman. The victims' bodies were recovered from the debris of the destroyed house and from nearby roads. According to investigations conducted by PCHR concerning this crime, at approximately 14:55 on Tuesday, 08 July 2014, an Israeli drone fired a missile at a 180-square-meter, 3-storey house belonging to Ahmed Mohammed Kaware, in which 5 families comprised of 21 individuals live, in Jouret al-Lout area in Khan Yunis. Residents of the house immediately left it and stayed 10 meters away. A large number of Palestinian civilians living in the area fathered inside and around the house to protect it, but Israeli warplanes disregard the presence of such high number of civilians, and fired a missile at the northwestern side of the house and destroyed it. As a result, 7 Palestinian civilians, including 5 children, were instantly killed, and 28 others, including 19 children and a woman, were wounded. A child died of wounds he sustained in this attack. The victims were identified as: 'Ammar Mohammed Jouda, 18; Hussein Yousef Hussein Kaware', 13; Mohammed Ibrahim 'Ouda Kaware', 50; Bassem Salem Kaware', 10; Mohammed Faraj 'Ata Kaware', 12; Abdullah Mohammed Ahmed Kaware', 12; Qassem Jaber 'Edwan Kaware', 12; and Siraj Eyad Abdul 'Aal, 8. The other houses that were attacked belong to the families of al-Shawaf, al-Braim, al-Sinwar, Abu Taha, al-Sha'er, Kaware' and Abu Tair. Additionally, at least 30 Palestinians, including a woman, were wounded in other attacks against Khan Yunis. The Central Gaza Strip: Israeli warplanes have launched 20 airstrikes using 30 missiles targeting houses, agricultural lands, open areas and members of Palestinian armed groups. As a result of these attacks, a Palestinian civilian and a member of an armed group were killed, and 65 Palestinians, including 27 women and 17 children, were wounded. Four houses were also destroyed. The two Palestinians who were killed were identified as: Salman Salama Abu Sawawin, 36, who was killed while riding a motorbike in Wadi al-Salqa village as Israeli forces fired a number of artillery shells at the area; and Rashad al-Din Abdul Rahman Yassin, 28, a member of a Palestinian armed group, who was directly targeted by an Israeli missile when he was on an agricultural plot. Israeli warplanes also destroyed a house belonging to the Abu Khater family in al-Nussairat refugee camp, another one belonging to the al-Tayeb family in al-Boreij refugee camp, and the Abu Tamma'a family in Deir al-Balah. An adjacent house was also destroyed, and dozens of nearby houses were heavily damaged. Gaza City: Israeli warplanes launched 42 airstrikes using 75 missiles targeting houses, civilians, members of and sites Palestinian armed groups, agricultural lands and open areas. As a result of these attacks, 5 Palestinians, including 3 civilians, were killed and 17 civilians, including 3 children and a woman, were wounded. Three houses were also destroyed. The two civilian victims were killed when an Israeli warplane launched 2 missiles at a motor cart they were riding in al-Shja'iya neighborhood in the east of Gaza City. They were identified as: Mohammed 'Aahed Mohammed Habeeb, 24; and Ahmed Mousa Khalaf Habeeb, 51. The three Palestinian activists were killed when Israeli warplanes fired 2 missiles at the car in which they were traveling in al-Wihda Street in the center of Gaza City. They were identified as: Mohammed Sa'id Ahmed Sha'ban, 24, from the northern Gaza Strip; Khader Hussein Ibrahim al-Bashliqi, 45, from al-Shuja'iya neighborhood in the east of Gaza City; and Amjad Juma'a Sa'id Sha'ban, 30, from the northern Gaza Strip. The houses that were destroyed belong to the families of al-Mamlouk and al-Haddad. Additionally, Ansar governmental complex in the west of Gaza City was extensively damaged. The Northern Gaza Strip: Israeli warplanes have launched 112 airstrikes using 114 missiles targeting houses, civilians, agricultural plots, open areas and training sites of Palestinian armed group. As a result of these attacks, 8 Palestinians were killed and 89 others, including 29 children and 20 women, were wounded. Six houses were completely destroyed. Six civilians, including 3 women, were killed when an Israeli warplane launched a missile at a house belonging to Abdul Hafez Hamad, a leader of Islamic Jihad. Hamad, his mother, his wife, his two brothers and his niece were killed when they were near the house: Rasmiya Khalil Mahmoud Hamad, 67; Mahdi Mohammed Hamad, 40; Abdul Hafez Mohammed Hamad, 38; Ibrahim Mohammed Hamad, 35; and Suha Hamad Hamad, 35. Additionally, 5 members of the same family, including 3 children and a woman, were wounded. The other Palestinians who were killed were identified as: Fakher'Aaref al-'Ajjouri, 22, who was killed when a cart he was riding was targeted; and Ahmed Nizar Mahdi, 15, who was killed when Israeli warplanes attacked a number of children who were playing in Jabalya. The targeted houses belong to the families of Abu Jarad, Shabat, Rajab, Abu 'Ajina, Salman and Abu 'Ouda. (PCHR Gaza 10 July 2014)

During the day (10th of July 2014):

- Three Palestinians were killed and four others were injured after the Israeli Occupation warplanes launched missiles at a Palestinian vehicle in Gaza city. One of the Palestinians was identified as: Baha Abu Al-Lail (35 years). (Maannews 10 July 2014)
- Eight Palestinians were killed and 30 others were injured after an Israeli airstrike attack a Palestinian house in Khan Younis city, south of Gaza strip. The 8 Palestinians were identified as: Asma', Tareq and Najla' Al-Haj, Aminah Al-Haj, Sad Al-Haj, Omar Al-Haj, Amih Al-Haj and Bassma Al-Haj (57 years). In Khan Younis also, an Israeli airstrike attack a Palestinian park at Khan Younis shore. Nine Palestinian were killed and 10 others were injured; Mohammad Khalid Qanann and his brother Ibrahim, Hamdi Kamel Sawali, Ibrahim Sawali, Suliman Al-Astal, Ahmed Al-Astal, Musa Al-Astal and Mohammad Al-'Aqad. An Israeli airstrike attack a Palestinian house in Bani Sahila area in Khan Younis. Isma'il Abu Al-Jame' (19 years) and Mohammad Ihsan Farawnih (19 years) were killed. (Maannews & Wafa 10 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation warplanes launched missiles at a Palestinian house in As-Sawarha neighborhood in Az-Zawieda village in the central of Gaza strip. The targeted house is owned by Shalt family. As a result,

four Palestinians were killed, father, mother and two children. (Maannews 10 July 2014)

- Israeli airstrikes attacked a Palestinian house owned by Zaqut family in Ash-Sheikh Radwan neighborhood in Gaza city. The house and a neighbor house were destroyed. (Maannews 10 July 2014)
- Abdalla Ramadan Abu Ghazal (5 years) killed after an Israeli missile hit his family house in Beit Lahiya town, north of Gaza strip. (Maannews 10 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation warplanes launched missiles at Palestinian houses in An-Nasirat refugee camp in the central of Gaza strip. The targeted houses are owned by An-Nawiri family. (Maannews 10 July 2014)
- Three Palestinians were injured after an Israeli missile hit a Palestinian house owned by Abd Al-Hay family in Rafah city, south of Gaza strip. (Maannews 10 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) destroyed Beit Hanun terminal, north of Gaza strip, after firing 8 missiles at it. (RB2000 10 July 2014)
- Three Palestinians were killed after the Israeli Occupation warplanes launched a missile at a Palestinian vehicle at As-Saftawi area, north of Gaza strip. (Paltoday 10 July 2014)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Hussen Yahya Hussen Na'irat (30 years) from Meithalun village, south of Jenin city, after stopping him at Za'tara military checkpoint, south of Nablus city. (Wafa 10 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians after storming and searching their houses in Tequ village, southeast of Bethlehem city. The arrestees were identified as: Ja'far Yousif Sabah (19 years) and Azz Ad-Diyn Khalid Sabah (20 years). (Wafa 10 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians from Ramallah city. The arrestees were identified as: Kamal Tawan and Wajdi 'Atirih. (Wafa 10 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Aymen Majadiba after storming his house in Tulkarm city. (Wafa 10 July 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested 5 Palestinians from Shufat town, 5 Palestinians from Ras Al-Amoud neighborhood and 2 Palestinians from the old city of Jerusalem city. Three of the arrestees were identified as: Ahmed Abu Nijma, Hassan Abu 'Asab and Mohammad Barakat. (Wafa 10 July 2014)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city and toured in its courtyard. (Quds Net 10 July 2014)
- Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Jabal Abu Al-Quron area, southwest of Nahhalin village, and set fire in Palestinian land planted with trees. (Wafa 10 July 2014)

Other

Court orders release of three suspects in Palestinian teen's murder. The • three are suspected of being part of the cell that kidnapped and killed 16-year-old Shufat resident Mohammed Abu Khdeir last week. Three of the six Jews suspected of being involved in the kidnapping and murder of 16-year-old Shufat resident Mohammed Abu Khdeir last week will be released from custody today, the Petah Tikva Magistrate's Court ruled Wednesday. The three are not suspected of the murder itself but of being part of the cell that committed it. The police and Shin Bet security service believe the murder was committed by the three main suspects – a 30-year-old man from a community near Jerusalem and two minors from the capital. Sources close to the investigation said the three main suspects confessed to the murder and reconstructed it. The three, who were arrested on the night between Saturday and Sunday, are likely to see their lawyers today, after a court banned them from doing so at the Shin Bet's request. The state told the court it was necessary to prevent the suspects from meeting with their lawyers for security reasons and in order to bring in additional suspects and evidence. Another suspect was arrested on Wednesday, but released a few hours later. The suspects' attorney Bentzi Kabler said, "We're pleased that what we said about the suspects has been proved true – three civilians were brutally arrested without having anything to do with the act. As for the other three suspects, we'll comment after meeting them." (Haaretz 10 July 2014)
