Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 03 June 2014

 \mathbf{T} he daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats occupied Palestinian territory, in the the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) confiscated an agricultural tractor in Beit Ummer town, north of Hebron city. The targeted tractor is owned by Ali Daoud Ghaiad Al-Alami. (Wattan 3 June 2014)
- Israeli Occupation gunboats opened fire at Palestinian fishing boats while they were sailing at As-Sudaniya shore, northwest of Gaza city. (Wattan 3 June 2014)

- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Nablus city. The IOA fired teargas grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Wattan 3 June 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed Joseph tomb in Balata refugee camp, east of Nablus city. Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA. (Wattan 3 June 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) fired teargas grenades at a Palestinian vehicle in Rummana village, northwest of Jenin city, causing two suffocation cases, the owner of the vehicle and his son. (Sama News 3 June 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Beit Ummer town, north of Hebron city. The IOA fired teargas and stun grenades at Palestinians, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Sama News 3 June 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) prevented dozens of Palestinians from entering Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city. (Wafa 3 June 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) opened fire and killed Ala' Mohammad Odeh (30 years) from Huwara village, south of Nablus city, while he was near Za'tara military checkpoint. (Wafa 3 June 2014)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Huwara village, south of Nablus city. The IOA fired teargas and stun grenades at Palestinians and houses. (Wafa 3 June 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded and searched two Palestinian houses in Al-Yamun village, northwest of Jenin city. The targeted houses are owned by: Nassem Mohammad Zayeed and Abd Al-Ra'ouf Khamisah. (Wafa 3 June 2014)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mus'ab Musa Meri' (17 years) after storming his family house in Qarawat Bani Hassan village, north of Salfit city. During the operation, the IOA invaded and searched several houses. (Al-Quds 3 June 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Amir Fawaz Al-Ja'bari (26 years) after raiding his house in Hebron city. The IOA transferred the arrestee to unknown location. (Safa 3 June 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested three Palestinians after stopping them at the entrance of Barta'a Ash-Sharqiya village, west of Jenin city. The arrestees were identified as: Ahmed Hussen Ibrahim from Jenin city, Ziyad Jamal Khalid from Jenin city and Amjad Ahmed Nimir Issa from 'Anin village. (Wattan 3 June 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians from Zububa village, northwest of Jenin city, after stopping them near the

segregation wall in the village. The arrestees were identified as: Laith Mohammad Zaghial (18 years) and Ahmed Jamal Jaradat (17 years). (Wattan 3 June 2014)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Isma'il Aliyan Ash-Shathli (26 years) after storming his house in Ad-Dhuheisheh refugee camp, south of Bethlehem city. (Wattan 3 June 2014)
- Undercover Israeli Army kidnapped two Palestinians while they were at As-Sinama area in Bethlehem city. One of the Palestinians was identified as Bassam Abd Al-Rahman Atiya Al-Hasanat from Ad-Dhuheisheh refugee camp in Bethlehem governorate. During the operation, the Israeli army fired teargas and stun grenades at Palestinians. (Sama News 3 June 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mujahed Jalal Qash (33 years) after storming and searching his family house in Birqin village, southwest of Jenin city. (Sama News 3 June 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Salamah Suliman Da'ajnah (16 years) after raiding his family house in Al-Fawar refugee camp, south of Hebron city. (Wafa 3 June 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Yousif Abd Al-Fatah Abu Sharkh (45 years) after storming his house in Ad-Dhahiriya town, south of Hebron city. (Wafa 3 June 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians from Dura town, west of Hebron city. The arrestees were identified as: Omar Ahmed Musa Abu Hlial and Ra'fat Isma'il Abu Hlial. (Wafa 3 June 2014)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli settlers assaulted and injured Rateb Yacoub Abu Irmilah (32 years) while he was at Tal Al-Rumida neighborhood in Hebron city. (Wafa 3 June 2014)
- Israeli settlers attacked Abd Al-Adem Salhab while he was at the courtyard of Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city. (Wafa 3 June 2014)
- Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed and toured in the courtyard of Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city, and performed Talmudic rituals. (Wafa 3 June 2014)

Israeli Closures

• Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) closed the northern entrance of Tequ village, southeast of Bethlehem city. The IOA prevented Palestinians from entering or leaving the village. (Wafa 3 June 2014)
