Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

01 November 2014

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats occupied Palestinian territory, the in the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers against Palestinian violence civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed and searched Al-Maloul neighborhood in Yabad town, west of Jenin city. The IOA erected a military checkpoint at the entrance of the town. (RB2000 1 November 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded and searched land and areas in Mirka village, south of Jenin city. (RB2000 1 November 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) raided and toured in Wadi Du'oq village, south of Jenin city. (RB2000 1 November 2014)

• Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked a non-violent protest against the closure of a road link between Surif and Jab'a villages, northwest of Hebron city. The IOA fired rubber bullets, teargas and stun grenades, causing dozens of suffocation cases. (Wafa 1 November 2014)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Mutasem Amjad Abu Rames (18 years) and Amjad Odeh Abu Rames to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etzion settlement bloc, after storming their houses in Ash-Shawawrah village, east of Bethlehem city. (Raya 1 November 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Waleed Musa Ash-Sheikh (38 years) and Musa Riziq Ash-Sheik (28 years) to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police in Gush Etzion settlement bloc, after raiding their houses in Marah Rabah village, south of Bethlehem city. (Raya 1 November 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained tens of Palestinian vehicles at Jit military checkpoint, west of Nablus city. The IOA stopped and searched vehicles and checked ID cards. (Pal Info 1 November 2014)

Expansion of settlements

• Israeli weekly newspaper "Kol Ha'ir" declared that an Israeli company started the implement of a project to build three buildings (each building will consist of 21-27 housing units) in Har Homa settlement. (Pal Info 1 November 2014)

Israeli Closures

• Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) closed a road link between Beit 'Awa and Al-Majd villages, west of Hebron city and Dura town, under the claim of "provide security"to the Israeli settlers who lives in Negehot settlement. (Pal Info 1 November 2014)
