## Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

29 November 2014

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

### Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) opened fire at Palestinians, houses and land in Al-Khaza'a town, east of Khan Younis city, south of Gaza strip. (Pal Info 29 November 2014)

### Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ahmed Ali Taleeb Ash-Shafi'I (18 years) after raiding his family house in Azkar refugee camp, east of Nablus city. (Maannews 29 November 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians from Al-Khader village, southwest of Bethlehem city. The arrestees were identified as: Abdalla Salah Ad-Diyn Salah (26 years) and Hisham Salah (23 years). (Shasha News 29 November 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Suhaib Muntasir Ar-Rimawi to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police, after raiding his house in Beit Rima village in Ramallah governorate. (Shasha News 29 November 2014)

### **Israeli Closures**

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) closed the southern entrance of Beitillu village, north of Ramallah city. The IOA prevented Palestinians from entering and leaving the village. (Shasha 29 November 2014)
