Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

11 October 2014

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

 Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded and searched several Palestinian houses in Al-Arroub refugee camp, north of Hebron city. At the same time, the IOA erected a military checkpoint at the entrance of the camp. (Pal Info 11 October 2014)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested 5 Palestinians after storming and searching their houses in Zawata village, north of Nablus city. The arrestees were identified as: Moayyad, Mutassem, Mohammad, Ahmed and Sadam Saqf Al-Hit. (Pal Info 11 October 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians after raiding and searching their houses in Nablus city. (Wafa 11 October 2014)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained two Palestinian journalists; Samer Rwished and Muaz Amarnih, while they were make a report about olive trees in Surif village, northwest of Hebron city. (RB2000 11 October 2014)

Israeli Settler Violence

• Israeli settlers living in Kfar Taquah settlement assaulted and injured Hana' Fathi Atiyani (30 years) while she was harvesting olive trees in her land in Yasouf village, northeast of Salfit city. Note that five days ago the Israeli settlers cut about 100 olive trees. (Wafa 11 October 2014)
