Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

10 November 2016

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

The daily report does not necessarily reflect ARIJ's opinion.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at the western entrance of Tuqu village, southeast of Bethlehem city. The IOA fired rubber bullets and teargas grenades, causing tens of suffocation cases. (Al-Quds 10 November 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded and searched tens of Palestinian houses in Ash Shuyyukh village, north of Hebron city. (Wafa 10 November 2016)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed and searched a Palestinian house in Al Jama'en village in Salfit governorate, and questioned the residents. (Maannews 10 November 2016)
- Israeli Occupation gunboats opened fire at Palestinian fishing boats while they were sailing at As Sudaniya shores, northwest of Gaza city. (Maannews 10 November 2016)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at 'Atara military checkpoint, north of Birzeit village, north of Ramallah city. The IOA fired live bullets and teargas grenades, causing the injury of Ansa Mahmoud Zayed (15 years), where the IOA arrested him. (Maannews & Wattan 10 November 2016)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at the southern entrance of Dura town, west of Hebron city. The IOA fired teargas and stun grenades, causing a number of suffocation cases. During the clashes, the IOA arrested a Palestinian and transferred him to unknown location. (Safa 10 November 2016)
- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) in Al Arroub refugee camp, north of Hebron city. The IOA fired teargas grenades, causing tens of suffocation cases. (Safa 10 November 2016)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested 6 Palestinians after storming and searching their houses in Marka village in Jenin Governorate. The arrestees were identified as: Bilal Abu Jalboush, Salah Ali Nafe' Musa, Ahmed Ali Nafe' Musa, Samir Shafiq, Nafe' Musa and Thair Muayyad Musa. (Sama News 10 November 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mas'oud Abu Al Wafa after storming and searching his house in Az- Zawiya village in Jenin governorate. (Sama News 10 November 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested five Palestinians in Al Khader village, southwest of Bethlehem city. The arrestees were identified as: Othman Jum'a Salah, Mohammad Rebhi Qatesh Musa, Ashraf Salah Ad Diyn Salah, Mahmoud Ghneim and Mahmoud Suliman Salah. (Safa 10 November 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Anas Mahmoud Salhab after raiding his family house in Hebron city. (Safa 10 November 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ahmed Waled Hamed (23 years) after storming and searching his family house in Silwad town, northeast of Ramallah city. (Safa 10 November 2016)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Amjad Safi (18 years) after raiding and searching his family house in Al Jalazoun refugee camp, north of Ramallah city. (Safa 10 November 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested three Palestinians from Jericho governorate. The arrestees were identified as: Abed Al Jabar Yousif Bsharat, Mus'ab Mohammad Jahaleen and Mohammad Mahmoud Jamous. (Wafa & Safa 10 November 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned Mohammad and Said and their father to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police, after raiding their house in AL Walaja village, west of Bethlehem city. (RB2000 10 November 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ali Samir Taqatqah after storming his family house in Beit Fajjar village, south of Bethlehem city. (RB2000 10 November 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested a Palestinian from Burqa village in Nablus governorate. (Safa 10 November 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Qassem Adel Abu Khader (21 years) from Qalqiliyah city. (Safa & Wafa 10 November 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested a Palestinian from Shufat refugee camp, north of Jerusalem city. (Safa 10 November 2016)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians from Hebron Governorate. The arrestees were identified as: Jamal Salman As Sarahnah and Yusri Masalmah. (Wafa 10 November 2016)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed Al Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city, and toured in its courtyard. (Wafa 10 November 2016)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) demolished two agricultural structures and a water tank in Qalqiliyah city. The targeted structures are owned by Abed Al Baset Khizaran and Hilmi Abadah. (Orient FM 10 November 2016)

Israeli Closures

- Israeli Occupation Authorities decided to close Gilo 300 military checkpoint, north of Bethlehem city , on the 10th of November 2016 from 10:00 a.m. to 11th November 2016 at 4:00 p.m. Also to close it on

the 12th of November from 5:00 p.m. until 13th of November at 10:00 p.m. (Maannews 10 November 2016)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) closed with cement a room in Yatta town, south of Hebron city. The targeted room is owned by the Palestinian prisoner in the Israeli Jail Younis 'Ayeshe Zein. (Maannews 10 November 2016)
