Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

3 December 2016

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Mohammed Jamal Yahya Hussein (24 years), from Al 'Araqa village west of Jenin city, on a flying checkpoint erected near Sabastiya village, also, they detained dozens of vehicles, and hindered the movement of citizens in both directions. - Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Osaid Allam Merhi, on a flying checkpoint erected near Qarawat Bani Hassan village, also, they

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) summoned two Palestinians to review the Israeli intelligence after raiding and searching their houses in Al 'Arrub Refugee camp, north of Hebron city. They Identified as: Bilal Ibrahim Abu Rayya (26 years) and Jaber al-Titi (60 years). (Wafa, 3 December 2016).
