Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

3 June 2017

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

Israeli Arrests

• Israeli occupation Army (IOA) detained two Palestinians from the village of al-Ubeidiya in eastern Bethlehem in the southern occupied West Bank during a dawn raid. The IOA Raided the village and detained two Palestinian youths, identified as Qutaiba Moussa Khalifeh, 18, and Muath Ramadan al-Assa, 22, after raiding and searching their homes. The detainees were transferred to an unidentified location. (Maannews 3 June 2017)

• The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) kidnapped two Palestinian young men upon their return to the West Bank from Jerusalem, where they performed prayers at the Aqsa Mosque. The two were identified as Mua'men Aqouba and Ibrahim Ladawi at a makeshift checkpoint. The checkpoint was set up especially to ambush and capture West Bank young men under age 40 after they entered Jerusalem to pray at the Aqsa Mosque. (PALINFO 3 June 2017)
