Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 16 July 2017

 ${f T}$ he daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats occupied Palestinian territory, the the in confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers against Palestinian civilians violence and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

 Israeli occupation Authorties (IOA) shot and killed a 34-year-old Palestinian man during a predawn raid near the village of Nabi Salih west of Ramallah in the central occupied West Bank, when another Palestinian, described as a "youth" by Israeli police, was also injured and detained. The killed Palestinians was identified as Ammar Ahmad Khalil. (Maannnews 16 July 2017)

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained 24-year-old Muhammad Khalil Farhat after raiding and searching his house in Hebron city in the southern occupied West Bank. (Maannews 16 July 2017).
- Israeli occupation army (IOA) installed military checkpoints at entrance to the village of al-Samu in the southern Hebron Govenorate and conducted security checks on all Palestinian residents passing in either direction. (Maannews 16 July 2017)
- In the town of Beit Ummar north of Hebron, Israeli occupation army (IOA) raided the house of Palestinian Martyr <u>Omar Arafat Issa</u> <u>Zaaqiq,19</u>. A large group of Israeli soldiers raided Zaaqiq's house, searched it and demanded Zaaqiq's father hand over all of the money in the house -- a common practice during Israeli raids on Palestinian homes -- under the allegation that the money had been given to him by Palestinian political factions. Ayyad said that Israeli soldiers confiscated Zaaqiq's vehicle, which he noted was worth 70,000 thousand shekels (\$19,686). Clashes erupted in the village during the raid, with the IOA firing tear gas canisters at Palestinians. (Maannews 16 July 2017)
- In the central Ramallah Governorate, Israeli police detained a Palestinian "youth" during a raid to arrest a man . The detainee was identified as Lutfi Muhamad Khalil, from the Ramallah-area village of Kafr Ein "after being injured." (Maannews 16 July 2017)
- In the central West Bank Governorate of Salfit, Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained 24-year-old Ayman Dafil Daghamin and 27-year-old Mahmoud Abd al-Latif Deik. (Maannews 16 July 2017)

Israeli Settler Violence

• Israeli settlers set up five illegal structures, on lands belonging to the village of al-Khader south of Bethlehem in the southern occupied West Bank. A group of settlers set up the new caravans in an attempt to expand the existing illegal outpost of Sde Boaz, built in the Wadi al-Ghawit area of al-Khader. Israeli authorities have been building a network of settler roads on the private lands of al-Khader in recent months. Most of the roads, were dirt roads, though some were asphalted. The network spanned nearly all the way to the nearby village of Nahhalin. (Maannews 16 July 2017)
