Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

1 December 2018

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

Israeli Arrests

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Hindaza area, east of the West Bank city of Bethlehem, and detained Mahmoud Sami Obeyyat, 23, after invading his home and searching it, in Hindaza.
- Dozens of Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the Deheishe refugee camp, south of Bethlehem, and searched several homes,

including the homes of Ismael al-Ja'fari and Mohammad Karim al-Atash, in an attempt to detain the latter but could not locate him. The IOA also fired many gas bombs and concussion grenades at protesters in the refugee camp.

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained a young Palestinian man from Beit Surik town, northwest of occupied East Jerusalem. The IOA invaded the home of the young man, and violently searched it, and detained him after interrogating him and several members of his family.
