Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

12 December 2018

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) injured at least twenty Palestinians in al-Bierreh city, in the central West Bank governorate of Ramallah and al-Bierreh, during ongoing and escalating offensives against Palestinians. The IOA shot twenty Palestinians, at least two of them with live fire, six with rubber-coated steel bullets, and twelve who suffered the severe effects of teargas inhalation, in the al-Irsal Street, in al-Bierreh city. The IOA stormed and ransacked many homes and shops

in the area, and confiscated surveillance equipment and recordings from several stores. In invasions also targeted the al-Masayef area in al-Biereh, where the soldiers stopped and searched dozens of Palestinian cars, and interrogated the residents while checking their ID cards, in addition to inspecting surveillance recordings, and invaded many shops. Protests also took place after dozens of IOA invaded the area near the Palestinian Finance Ministry, and stormed a shop, before detaining its workers and confiscated surveillance recordings. The IOA fired dozens of concussion grenades and gas bombs, in addition to many live rounds and rubber-coated steel bullets at the protesters in the area, in addition to attacking local journalists, preventing them from performing their duties and threatening to abduct them if they do not leave. - The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) shot three Palestinians from Sarda village, north of the central West Bank city of Ramallah, as the IOA were withdrawing from al-Biereh adjacent city. The IOA shot one Palestinian with a live round in his leg, while he was at a hilltop in the village. The IOA also shot two other Palestinians with live rounds in Sarda, during protests that lasted for nearly six hours. Dozens of Palestinians suffered the effects of teargas inhalation, in addition to various cuts and bruises. The IOA also invaded a few homes, and occupied the rooftop of one of them, using it as a military port and a monitoring tower. (IMEMC 12 December 2018)
- A child died from serious wounds he suffered after The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) shot him, east of Khan Younis, in the southern part of the Gaza Strip. The child was identified as Ahmad Yasser Sabri Abu 'Aabed, 4, and he was shot with expanding bullets, one in his eye, and one in his abdomen, causing very serious wounds. (IMEMC 12 December 2018)

Israeli Arrests

- In Jenin, in northern West Bank, the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained

Riyad Mohammad Kabaha, and his brother Eyad, in addition to Mahdi Jihad Kabaha, and confiscated three cars. (IMEMC 12 December 2018)

- In Ramallah and al-Biereh governorate, in central West Bank, the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Mansour Shaltaf, Ishaq Shahhad Qadadha and Ali Ishaq Qadadha. (IMEMC 12 December 2018)
- In Hebron, in southern West Bank, the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained a young man, identified as Ahmad Mahmoud al-Hoor, from his home in Surif town. (IMEMC 12 December 2018)
- In occupied Jerusalem, the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Sho'eib Askar, from Hizma town, east of the city. (IMEMC 12 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the southern West Bank city of Hebron, and the nearby towns of Surif and Yatta, searched several homes and detained one Palestinian. The IOA detained a young man, identified as Ahmad Mahmoud al-Hoor, from his home in Surif town, west of Hebron, after violently searching and ransacking his property. (IMEMC 12 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded homes in Yatta town, south of Hebron, including the home of Younes Heinz, a political prisoner serving a life-term in Israeli prisons. (IMEMC 12 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded and searched several homes, owned by members of al-Ja'ba family, in Jabal Johar area, in addition to the home of Issa Baradeyya, in the al-Kassara area, in Hebron city. (IMEMC 12 December 2018)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Dozens of Israeli occupation Army (IOA) invaded the campus of Al-Quds University in Abu Dis town, southeast of occupied East Jerusalem, and searched it causing excessive property damage, in addition to confiscating surveillance equipment and recordings. The IOA damaged many doors, desks and offices, especially while

searching rooms of various student blocks. The IOA also confiscated surveillance recordings and equipment from the university. The invasion came just a few hours after the army stormed the area near campus, and fired dozens of gas bombs, concussion grenades, live rounds and rubber-coated steel bullets, at protesters, who hurled stones and empty bottles at them.

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Beit Hanina, north of Jerusalem, and demolished a parking structure, for “being built without a permit. The IOA surrounded the entire area, and isolated it, before demolishing the structure, owned by Anwar Doula. (IMEMC 12 December 2018)
