## Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

26 October 2018

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

## Israeli Arrests

- In Qalqilia, the Israeli occupation Army (IOA) detained Ahmad Raslan Qawwas, 18, in the northern part of Qalqilia city, after the army invaded it, and took him to an unknown destination. (IMEMC 26 October 2018)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) detained a child, identified as Ayman Ammar Abu Aisha, 14, in the Bab az-Zawiya area, in the center

of Hebron city. The army claimed several youngsters hurled stones at the IOA, stationed at the permanent military roadblock, installed at the entrance of the Shuhada Street, and chased the Palestinians, before detaining the child. (IMEMC 26 October 2018)

 Palestinian parliament member <u>Khalida Jarrar</u>, has been in prison since July 2 of 2017, and her sentence has been extended by four additional months. Jarrar was initially detained in 2015, spent 14 months in Israeli prison, and spent a year free. Her detention has been renewed in December 2017, June 2018, and again in October. ## Israeli Settler Violence

 A GROUP OF Israeli settlers installed tents in the Ibrahimi Square, next to the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron's Old City, and surrounded it with iron bars and barbed-wire fences, in preparation for establishing a new outpost. (IMEMC 26 October 2018)
