Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

3 December 2018

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

 Several armored Israeli military vehicles invaded Palestinian lands in the eastern area of the central part of the Gaza Strip. The vehicles, accompanied by four armored military bulldozers, carried out a limited invasion into the Palestinian farmlands in the area east of the al-Maghazi refugee camp. The bulldozers uprooted lands near the perimeter fence, and installed sand hills, while military drones hovered overhead. (IMEMC 3 December 2018)

- Israeli navy ships fired several live rounds at Palestinian fishing boats, in northern Gaza waters. (IMEMC 3 December 2018)
- Clashes Erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) IN Birzeit town north of Ramallah city after the latter raided a number of buildings in the town. The IOA interrogated a number of Palestinians and checked their ID cards. (IMEMC 3 December 2018)
- At the 18th weekly Naval March, hundreds of Palestinians gathered along the northern coast of the besieged Gaza Strip. Nine Palestinians were injured by projectiles shot by the Israeli army, while dozens of other protesters suffocated from tear gas. The nine casualties include 1 hit with live ammunition, 4 with rubber-coated steel bullets, and 4 were shot with teargas canisters. The Israeli Navy also opened fire at the 30 Palestinian boats as they attempted to break the siege. (IMEMC 3 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Beit Ummar town, north of Hebron, in the southern part of the West Bank, attacked many residents and stores, before firing gas bombs at Palestinians who protested the invasion, causing dozens to suffer the effects of teargas inhalation. The invasion targeted several areas in Beit Ummar, but was mainly focused in 'Aseeda and Ras al-'Ein. The IOA invaded Beit Ummar and started shutting stores down, in addition to stopping and searching dozens of Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards. The IOA closed the main road in Beit Ummar, and prevented the Palestinians from entering it. The IOA also distributed leaflets, warning more severe measures in the town, "should the Palestinian youngsters continue to throw stones at the military and settlers' vehicles." Dozens of Palestinians protested the invasion and hurled stones at the military jeeps, while the ioa fired gas bombs, concussion grenades and rubber-coated steel bullets. (IMEMC 3 December 2018)

Israeli Arrests

 The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Muhammad Bassam Al Orabi after raiding his family house in in Jenin Camp in the northern West Bank and assaulting him. The IOA also assaulted family

- members and questioned them over Muhammad's activities. (WAFA 3 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Said Ali Qablawi after raining his family house. (WAFA 3 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained five Palestinians from Al Khader village west of Bethlehem after raiding their families' houses. The detained five were identified as Daoud Oar Salah, Ahmad Ibrahim Ghneim, Thaer Riad Salah, Osama Salah Ad Din Salah, Muhammad Fawwaz Salah (WAFA 3 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained two Palestinians in Al Arroub refugee camp north of Hebron city after raiding their families' homes and ransacking contents. The two were identified as Qusai Wisan Nayef Badawi, 14, and Munjed Ahmad Al Badawi. (WAFA 3 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Azzam Hamara, 24, from Husan village west of Bethlehem city after raiding his family houses and searching it.
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Ahmad Zaran Khalil, 19, from Azzun town east of Qalqilyia city after raiding his family houses and ransacking contents. (WAFA 3 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained three Palestinians in Tulkarem camp. The three were identified as Raed Muhmmad Quza, 48, Jamal Hadayda, 50 and Baker Muhammad Kharboush. (WAFA 3 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Hani Binan Suwwan, 21, from Dhannaba outskirt east of Tulkarem. (WAFA 3 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Laith Afif Al Eteli from Attil town north of Tukarem city. (WAFA 3 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Othman Zeid from Jifna village north of Ramallah city after raiding his family houses and ransacking contents. (WAFA 3 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Abdel Salam Abed from Al Am'ari camp in Ramallah. (WAFA 3 December 2018)
- In Ramallah, in central West Bank, the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded several towns in the governorate, and violently searched many homes, causing damage. The IOA detained Othman Zeid and Abdul-Salam 'Aabed, and took them to an unknown destination. (IMEMC 3 December 2018)
- In Tulkarem, in northern West Bank, the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained four former political prisoners, identified as Raed Mohammad Qozah, 48, and Hani Suwwan, Bakr Mohammad

- Kharyoush, 27, and Mohammad Suleiman, in addition to Jamal Hadayda, 50. (IMEMC 3 December 2018)
- In Qalqilia, in northern West Bank, the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Ahmad Zahran Salim, 19. (IMEMC 3 December 2018)
- In Bethlehem, the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded and searched homes in the al-Khader town, south of the city, and detained Daoud Salah, in addition to three former political prisoners, identified as Mohammad Salah, Tha'er Salah, Osama Salah and Ahmad Ghneim. (IMEMC 3 December 2018)
- the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained in Shu'fat refugee camp, in occupied Jerusalem, Mahmoud Sheikh, after stopping him at Hizma military roadblock, north of the city. (IMEMC 3 December 2018)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) demolished residential structures and sheep barns in the northern Jordan Valley that belong to the family of Zayid in the village of Fasayel, noting that they also raided a number of homes and stole an amount of money from one of them, without specifying the amount. (WAFA 3 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) seized agricultural tools used to raise poultry in the town of Barta'a, southwest of the city of Jenin, and an agricultural room in Majdal Bani Fadel village, south of Nablus, in the north of the occupied West Bank. The IOA raided Barta'a and the place he uses to raise chicken and seized tools worth of \$250,000. (WAFA 3 December 2018)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) seized an agricultural structure in Majdal Bani Fadel that belonged to a woman farmer identified as Magboola Nasrallah Hammad Uthman. (WAFA 3 December 2018)
