Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 19 May 2019

I he daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats occupied Palestinian territory, the the in confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked many Palestinian Muslim worshipers in the al-Aqsa Mosque, in occupied Jerusalem, and forced them out of the holy site's compound. The IOA attacked many worshipers, before forcing them out of the holy site. (IMEMC 19 May 2019)
- The Israeli Agriculture Minister, Yuri Ariel, invaded the Al-Aqsa Mosque along with at least 17 settlers, accompanied by dozens of police officers and Israeli Occupation Army (IOA), through the al-Magharba Gate, and conducted a provocative tour in the holy site's courtyards. (IMEMC 19 May 2019)
- Israeli police officers uprooted many olive saplings that were planted by the Palestinian worshipers in Bab ar-Rahma area, in the Al-Aqsa Compound. (IMEMC 19 May 2019)
- A 5-year old Palestinian child from Gaza who was finally allowed permission to travel to Jerusalem for a complicated brain surgery was forced to travel alone when Israeli authorities denied her parents' permission to accompany her. She suffered from a brain tumor and died soon after the surgery. Aisha Lulu, 5 years old, from al-Bureij refugee camp in central Gaza, died after returning to Gaza from surgery in Jerusalem, and a harrowing journey through numerous Israeli checkpoints that she had to endure alone. None of Lulu's family members were allowed by Israel to be on her side in hospital as applications by her family members to accompany her to Jerusalem for her complicated brain surgery were denied. She had to travel with a woman, who wasn't her mother or even related to her, and was allowed by Israel to accompany her. (IMEMC 19 May 2019)

Israeli Arrests

• The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained a young Palestinian man in Teqoua' town, south of Bethlehem, in the occupied West Bank identified as Amer Ra'fat Zayyah, 25, after breaking into his home and violently searching it. Dozens of IOA invaded the town, and fired many life rounds, gas bombs and concussion grenades. (IMEMC 19 May 2019)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained a young Palestinian man in Kafr 'Aqab town, north of occupied East Jerusalem. The IOA invaded the town, searched homes and detained a young man, identified as Mohammad Sobeh. The IOA also installed a military roadblock, and prevented many Palestinians from leaving the town. (IMEMC 19 May 2019)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the al-Biereh city, near Ramallah in central West Bank, and were heavily deployed in the area of the al-Biereh-Jerusalem road, especially around a building there. (IMEMC 19 May 2019)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded, Silwan town, south of the Al-Aqsa Mosque in occupied East Jerusalem, and detained a Palestinian teen identified as Yazan Mohammad Froukh, 16, from his home. The IOA invaded the teen's family home, and violently searched it, in addition to confiscating mobile homes, owned by members of his family. (IMEMC 19 May 2019)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained a young Palestinian man in Kafr 'Aqab town, north of occupied East Jerusalem. The IOA invaded the town, searched homes and detained the young man, identified as Mohammad Sobeh. The IOA also installed a military roadblock, and prevented many Palestinians from leaving the town. (IMEMC 19 May 2019)

Israeli Settler Violence

• Israeli Minister of Agriculture Uri Ariel, headed a group of Israeli settlers in a provocative tour of the holy Al-Aqsa Mosque compound, in occupied Jerusalem. Ariel and dozens of settlers toured the holy site in groups, only hours after Israeli police forcibly evicted hundreds of Muslim worshippers from the holy site. (IMEMC 19 May 2019) • Many Israeli settlers accompanied by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA), invaded the area of the evacuated Homish settlement, south of the northern West Bank city of Jenin. The settlers also obstructed traffic and attempted to attack several Palestinians on the nearby Jenin-Nablus road. (IMEMC 19 May 2019)
